

Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) Faculty of Fine Arts (GSF) Gastronomy and Culinary Arts Department Research Assistant Ayşe Seray Çetin's article titled "Investigation of peanut residue in cakes sold in Istanbul" was published in the journal Food and Health.

"Peanut is the most dangerous of all food allergens. Therefore, it is the most common cause of fatal foodborne anaphylaxis in developed and developing countries. Individuals with peanut allergy are at risk of exposure to peanuts in situations such as the use of peanutcontaminated raw materials, cross-contamination during processing, unintentional allergen transfer from shared equipment, deliberate inclusion or non-compliance with labeling rules.[...]"

Assistant Professor Pelin Aykut Answered Our Questions About Her Academic Life And Museum Studies

Hello, first of all, can we get to know you a little bit?

Art/architecture historiography, museology and journal/ book editorship are the fields that make up my life story and make me exist. I graduated from Mimar Sinan Fine Arts University, Art History. I completed my Master's and Doctorate at Istanbul Technical University, Faculty of Architecture, Department of History of Architecture. I am honored to have met, worked with and learned from valuable teachers who are experts in their fields and who are defined as doyens in their fields in every period. Of course Prof. Dr. Afife Batur has a special place as both my master's and doctoral advisors. It is impossible to pass without mentioning what he has contributed to me on a human and professional level and his work on me.

You have 25 years of museology history. How did you start this work? How did you transition into academia? Can you tell us about this process?

Yes, twenty-five years of museology and museum management are undoubtedly very enjoyable and learning years. In this period, besides inventory studies, there are also exhibition and museum installation works. I can say that the

institution where I spent twenty-five years was also a school for me at every level. However, I would also like to talk about my first job, which was the first job I started working in, as an editor. I started working as a magazine/book editor at Yapı Kredi Publishing while I was doing my master's degree. Reading and writing were important in every part of my life. I learned the business there, in a sense, in the kitchen of writing and publishing. I had the opportunity to meet and work with many famous writers and publishers.

How did your museology experience contribute to your lessons?

We have realized numerous projects, exhibitions, publications and seminars as researchers and administrators in museum palaces with the most beautiful views of Istanbul, such as Dolmabahçe Palace, Beylerbeyi Palace, Ihlamur Palace, and Beykoz Palace, which left their mark on the 19th century. As an academician, I am very happy to use these experiences that I have been in, in the lessons that I try to convey to my students. I can say that it is extremely important in my professional career that I get to know these unique landmarks of 19th century Istanbul both in terms of space and with the items that make up the buildings, and to have the opportunity to work on each item and create an inventory. Likewise, the installation work of the National Palaces Painting Museum is also very valuable. I think that even the idea of being involved in the project of creating a museum from scratch with modern exhibition methods and materials in a historical place is sufficiently developing and meaningful. In fact, I see teaching as an art of sharing one's own knowledge and experience with others. I say that I see it as art because most of the time it is not enough just to have knowledge; ways and style of sharing are of greater importance.


What would you recommend to your students?

I advise my dear students to read more, listen more and look. For this, it is very valuable for them to visit historical places starting from Istanbul, the city where they received their university education, and to create archives by taking lots of photos. As I always say in lectures, theoretical lectures create a wealth of information that comes to help when we call them during the design process. Therefore, visualizing what has been learned is just as important.

Interview with Elif Hacıoğlu, Graduate Student of the Department of Interior Architecture and Environmental Design

Hello Elif, you have successfully graduated from the Department of Interior Architecture and Environmental Design, how was the education process for you?

I was a student of Interior Architecture and Environmental Design Double Major Program (DMP). I had a very enjoyable time. My education process was open to interdisciplinary work and continuous learning. The process teaches you to identify, explore and solve problems creatively. It is very important to know and observe the material, it is very useful for us, especially after the jury processes graduate and go to the working process. It teaches you how to present your project and renews your self-confidence. I am glad that I applied to the Double Major Program of the Department of Interior Architecture and Environmental Design and I am glad I made such a choice.

How did you shape your career after graduation?

While I was studying, I had career plans that I aimed for. In fact, I took care not to go outside and develop it. Currently, I am continuing my duty with a job related to Major and Double Major fields. I think continuity is very important for goals.

Can you talk about the goals you want to achieve in your career?

It may not be right to tell them step by step. But I give myself advice and suggestions. Raise your goals, be open to

criticism, nurture yourself constantly, and put forward your ideas in interdisciplinary projects.

What are your recommendations to students studying at the Department of Interior Architecture and Environmental Design?

My first suggestion is continuity and continuity. Because if these things happen, even if your drawings are not good in the first place, the continuous and continuous process will improve your skills. I suggest that subjects such as program information about interior space, material information, design analysis, space planning, aesthetic sensitivity, job follow-up at the construction site should be followed well. Although this process is a difficult one, the people you train and feed with are very important, I am grateful to my teachers on this issue. I am still in contact with my teachers. Because even though I graduate, I have a lot to ask and learn.

Would you recommend Gelisim University to students who want to study in the Department of Interior Architecture and Environmental Design?

I definitely recommend it because it is a department that aims to keep the standards at the highest level by providing a quality education where you can constantly improve yourself.






What is a
