



Mold..!

The movie "Mold" tells the story of the railway worker Basri, whose university student son was taken into custody 18 years ago and was never heard from again. Basri, desperately hoping for 18 years, wrote a petition to the relevant institutions twice a month to find his son, who could not be heard from, but could not get a result. The movie is based on the theme of Basri's character waiting for his son for 18 years.

When we examine the characters in the movie, we see that there are main characters (Basri) and side characters (Cemil, Polis). It can be said that our main character, Basri, is successful in making the audience believe himself in terms of his physiological and sociological characteristics. However, the feature that makes Basri's character deep and makes the audience share his expectation is his psychological structure.

We can observe the traumatic effect of the events that the character experiences in all his states, movements, gestures and mimics. Due to the deep cracks created by the events he experienced, he isolated himself from the environment he lived in, and retreated into his own shell, so to speak. In addition, he continues to live his life at that pace in parallel with the act of waiting. Cemil, one of the other characters, is also a worker on the railways like Basri.

The character of Cemil is the opposite of Basri and was created for a dramatic conflict between them. In the movie, Cemil is portrayed as a character who can do all kinds of evil to those who are weaker than him and submit to those who are stronger than him. The one who is called 'bad' in our social life is someone who does almost everything. Since the character of Cemil is not processed as deeply as Basri, it turns into a 'type' that had to be created far from being convincing.

Throughout the movie, we see Cemil verbally abusing Basri. Verbal abuse turns into threats when Cemil is caught with Basri while he is with a woman at work. The tension between the two characters reaches its peak when Cemil learns that Basri also has epilepsy. Afterwards, Cemil's death, which is the breaking point of the movie, takes place. With this death, many concepts such as justice, conscience, crime and criminal begin to be questioned again. The key point of the movie is that a person who has been a victim for 18 years suddenly becomes a criminal and even does it by doing nothing. Is doing nothing a crime? Isn't keeping quiet about everything a kind of complicity in the crime?

The message to be given with questions is conveyed to the audience. Along with these, it can be said that one of the weakest link in the movie is the police character. A police prototype is drawn, tired of the letters he has received from Basri for 18 years and trying to 'convince' him to give up his hopeless dream of meeting his son. The effort of the police to convince Basri to stop looking for his son, and the discovery of his son's bones after 18 years, a Turkish policeman who made an effort and finally came to a conclusion, is the most obvious of the contradictions in the film.

Since the movie "Mold" shows the current state of Basri, who lost his son 18 years ago - the event described the unsolved murders in Turkey in the 90s - it can be thought of as 2010 and later. The long plans used in the film also make the audience share in Basri's hopeful waiting for his son. Along with Nuri Bilge Ceylan's cinema, the concept of depicting the slow flow of time in the countryside with static images is also seen in Mold. In the film, the rhythm of the countryside is captured by the walking scenes that depict Ali Aydın Basri's waiting for his son with long plans for 90 minutes, and the waiting moments that show Basri's loneliness.

The film takes place in the country where a simple, ordinary railroad worker lives the bitter realities of the 90s. Spatially, the use of indoor and outdoor spaces has been used more or less proportionally. Basri's house and place of work, as well as the police room, were used as interior spaces, and nature as exterior spaces. When we examine Basri's house, it was established to show the economic and social status of the character. However, the house allows Basri to experience his loneliness by closing his door, window and even the light by alienating his surroundings.

Although the film "Mold" is close to Nuri Bilge Ceylan's cinema in terms of narrative, it differs from it thematically. When the dramatic structure of the film is examined, it is shaped with rules in accordance with the classical narrative structure. The use of time and space in the film is used in accordance with the psychological structure of the character of Basri. Mold allows us to confront the past by telling a simple language about the period of extrajudicial executions and tortures in the early 1990s, both in terms of its subject and its way of expression.

Today, with technology and the internet becoming an indispensable and almost vital function, the time spent in the virtual environment has been increasing. Thus, a large and innovative virtual ecosystem that covers digital socialization, relationships, digital properties and social areas has started to show itself. While they can use their own identities while doing this, they also use avatars that they are or want to be in a virtual sense and are defined as a body. In other words, face-to-face relationships and interpersonal communication have changed dimensions and become more visible in virtual environments. Metaverse Universe is the most talked about one of these virtual environments today and perhaps referred to as the world of the future.

With Metaverse, which is a very new technology and is in the development stage, users can establish a real life in the virtual universe, create a connection with reality by creating a feeling similar to their experiences in the physical world with the depth perception and three-dimensional illusion it creates. Thanks to this connection, since the illusion of reality is at a high level, it is predicted that he wants to continue his consumption habits as in physical life, and even tends to spend much more time and money with the desire to live the self he wants to be.

The concept of Metaverse, which is derived from the Greek words 'meta' meaning 'beyond' and 'verse' meaning 'universe' by deriving from the word 'universe', means 'beyond universe', 'other universe', 'virtual universe' or 'meta universe'. trying to be identified by names.

Metaverse, whose seeds have been planted with technologies such as AR (augmented reality), virtual reality, wearable technologies, blockchain, NFT, artificial intelligence, mixed reality, robotics and the internet of things (IoT), is still in the development stage as a very new technology. Although the metaverse universe has not yet been put into a conceptual framework, it is seen in a structure that many corporate companies and developers, especially consumers, are already in high demand and will become clearer over time. The concept of Metaverse, which is accepted as the pinnacle of virtual reality in terms of technology, is accepted as the future of digital media because of its rapid adaptation to the physical world.

"Philosophy of Science" Dominique Lecourt

Professor of Philosophy at the University of Paris, Dominique Lecourt teaches in the fields of science and philosophy of education. Even from a randomly opened page, it is possible to observe how competent and competent he is in his field. The Turkish publishing rights of the book "Philosophy of Science", in which the author brings his knowledge and unique perspective to the reader with logical foundations, belong to Dost Publishing House, the translation was done by Işık Ergüden and the technical preparation was carried out by Ferhat Babacan.

It is possible to state that the book, which consists of 22 chapters and 143 pages, is a useful work that mainly deals with the relationship between philosophy and science, conveys information diversified with the views of the thinkers who made their name in history, and gives new perspectives.

He mentioned in the first sentences of the book that the need for physical science has increased, science has been developed, and physics has brought benefits to humanity with tangible returns, the ways of science and philosophy have been separated with a sharper line, science has been further embodied and pioneered, and philosophy has been compressed in areas such as religion, law, morality, and art. The fact that he conveys what he thinks is an assurance that the following pages of the book will bring the reader a reading process that is in harmony with science and philosophy and the relationship between them.

It is possible to observe throughout the book that the author attaches importance to conceptual discussions and the evaluation of the subject in historical order. The formation processes of the concepts of philosophy and science and the definitions brought to the concepts they brought with them, the detailed transfer of their situations in the ancient and modern periods, respectively, the process of the emergence of the concept of "philosophy of sciences" by bringing the two concepts together, the periods of convergence and divergence, the situations that cause periodic differences or differences. the views of the thinkers who shaped it were included and conveyed clearly; Especially after the 4th chapter, in almost every chapter, a thinker and a subject he focused on were discussed in detail and presented to the reader.

The author dealt with the views of important thinkers on the stage of history such as Auguste Comte, Wittgenstein, Popper, Kant, Duhem, Jean Piaget, from time to time comparatively, but in a generally objective language, in depth that would not bore the reader; It made it possible for the reader to form an opinion on the subject when they passed the chapters, and sometimes succeeded in drawing the reader to the opposite side of his thought in the next chapter.

It can be said that it has a simpler, more understandable and fluent language, especially when compared to other books written in the field of philosophy of science written by local authors. He explained to the reader the concept of logic, which he frequently referred to especially from the 6th chapter, the new philosophical thought (positivism), which was created by the Vienna environment, which constitutes a very important turning point for philosophy, and encourages philosophy to be completely directed and fed into science, in a very understandable language; He presented the common denominator of different views and the logical framework that dominated the period with transfers, examples and comparisons in a way that could attract the attention of even a reader who has no knowledge or interest in the period and could gain a certain dominance on the subject.

In general, the book offers the reader a wide range of knowledge in fields such as philosophy, science and philosophy of science; The fact that the author presents the historical process and the views of famous thinkers in a systematic way rather than his personal ideas in most chapters provides the reader with informational satisfaction. However, it seems possible that the reader will have to move on to the next chapter without finding a basis on which to base his opinion.

Another issue that should be mentioned is the author's historical ordering problem. The insistence of the author, who tries to present the events in the order in the historical process, has created ruptures between the chapters. While the topic covered in one chapter is expected to continue in the other chapter, the relevant topic comes up again after 3-4 chapters; This can cause you to have difficulties while reconciling the subjects

The book is a work that can attract the attention of someone who has mastered the field of philosophy of science in general, and can even be a first step for those who are just starting to be interested. It is thought to be a book that can be recommended in terms of the clarity of its language, its superficial handling of the topics without boring and tiring the reader, keeping the reader's attention on the topic by not giving place to unnecessary information. However, it is recommended to read slowly and digestingly - the reader should have a notebook with him while reading - since it contains a broad knowledge base that cannot be read in one breath.

Interview

Director Emre Kavuk:

"Cinema as a mass media is still the biggest art form that affects the masses!"

Dear Emre Kavuk, thank you very much for accepting our FoAS e-Bulletin interview. And we want to ask right away, how and why did you choose the directorial profession?

I reckon the biggest factor in choosing this profession is that I started watching movies at a young age. I did not know in those years that I would make such a decision in the future, but as I watched movies and loved cinema, the desire to do something about cinema started to form. The truth is, I didn't know that cinema had a school. I had not researched. After high school, while I was wondering if I could write a screenplay or shoot a movie, I learned that it was a school, and that's how I decided to study cinema. I guess the only answer I can give to the question of why I chose this profession is that I don't like to tell stories...

As a very young director, you are in a period and profession at the center of the rapid transformation in the field of communication. Can you evaluate the situation of the cinema industry in connection with digital developments?

When I started university, digital cameras began to multiply and enter our lives. In fact, it started to become much more economical. In this way, it became much easier for us young people to shoot movies.

I think we've all seen the benefits of that. In the following years, this situation has become more common and more accessible with the digital world. To sum up, making a movie is very easy now. However, the most important element here is "content". Although making a movie has become easy, creating a story and telling something is still as difficult as it used to be. That's why I see digitalization positively, but this alone is not enough.

At this point, I think, with all this transformation, the future of cinema gains importance... What do you think will be the future of cinema? Could you please evaluate the situation of the cinema industry in Turkey as a mass media?

A phenomenon that has been discussed and confronted since the beginning of cinema has been the question of whether cinema is ending. The advent of sound cinema or the transition to color films, the emergence of videos or the digital platforms that enter our homes today have always brought up the question "Is cinema dead or will movie theaters close?" However, cinema as a mass media is still the biggest art branch that affects the masses. Although cinema has shifted to various channels with technology, I think the art of cinema as a content will be a means of reaching people in the future as it is today. As an industry, the TV series industry has gained a place in the world at the moment, our domestic productions, especially our TV series, are exported abroad, and I think this will be positive for the future of the industry. Ultimately, as exports to abroad increase, the formal quality of domestic productions will increase. Likewise, if the producers invest what they earn from TV series and cinema in this sector, it will be a gain in terms of the growth of our sector and the existence of different jobs. However, there is another important detail here, which is the diversification of the content.

Mr. Emre Kavuk, what do you think are the difficulties/issues and conveniences/most easily manageable situations of directorship?

I can talk about two aspects of directing here. The first is the process of making a film as a director, and the second is the content and formal dimension of the film. Content and form is a vast field. Here, as a director, it is very important how a person develops himself, what he wants to tell and how he tells it. In particular, questions such as what is his worldview about the subject he wants to tell, what is his sentence on this subject come to the fore. That's why this area is about how much the person has developed himself and how much he has mastered the cinema. The other element is the filmmaking process. It should be summarized as follows. If a person can organize a wedding alone, they can also manage the film production process, there is no difference.

Dear Emre Kavuk, what are your suggestions for our young students who want to be directors?

My suggestion here can be my own experience. They should be watching too many movies, reading too much and then making short films without saying good or bad. Because this work has a theoretical dimension, I also think that cinema is an art learned in the field.

Dear Emre Kavuk, thank you very much for the information you provided.

I would like to thank you for bringing me together with young director candidates.
