

Technology Transfer Office of Istanbul Gelisim University creates an added-value by its robotic studies and by increasing production based on industry. The projects related to advanced level robotic studies are carried out at the Technology Transfer Office, and these advanced robotic studies have proven themselves in many national and international robot competitions. Moreover, many significant projects were developed in the robotic sector. These studies were represented in the best manner by participating in fairs, events and promotion days organized on the basis of national and international innovation.













2.2. Partnerships for Technology Development and R&D Support

As the importance attached to technology, R&D and innovation have increased in accordance with National Science, Technology and Innovation Strategy, increasing technology and innovation activities in a private sector-oriented manner, commercialization of research results and increasing the competitiveness of our country with branded technology-intensive products are among our main goals specified by our country.

In this regard, the main goal of Istanbul Gelisim University is to increase the support given to technology, R&D and innovation studies and to support the cooperation and joint study culture in this field in accordance with the 11th Development Plan.

In accordance with this goal, the researchers and academics of Istanbul Gelisim University develop national and international projects while our research and application centres, aiming to produce knowledge and value as well as to conduct quality research and publication to transform these productions into economic added value, contribute to this vision by establishing partnerships and cooperation with other research institutions at home and abroad. In order to fulfil all these activities, there are 21 Research and Application Centers at Istanbul Gelisim University.

• Evaluation of Energy Systems Security in the Scope of Cyber Security

Today, the increasing dependency on Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) and especially the Internet in energy systems has made it necessary to provide cyber security in these systems. Cyber security incidents that may occur in information technologies used in energy systems; It includes the risks of stopping and disrupting energy services, causing large-scale economic damage, disruption of public order, loss of life and even endangering the national security of countries. The purpose of this research; To draw the general framework of the concepts of cyber security in energy systems, to investigate the cyber attacks against energy systems, to reveal the importance of cyber security in critical infrastructures managed with SCADA, especially in energy systems infrastructures, and to make suggestions for increasing current awareness on this issue. The descriptive method was used in the research. The information obtained in the research is that providing cyber security in energy systems is of vital importance. Among the suggestions made in the study, it was especially











emphasized to use national cyber security information technologies and products, which were designed and tested by accredited domestic security consultancy companies that have passed national cyber security tests and have national certification, especially in the energy sector in Turkey.

• Identity Analysis and Notification System on People Diagnosed with Covid-19 with Erel Binary Patterns Histograms

It is aimed to develop a different system from other face recognition systems by adding functionality to face recognition systems used in many fields today. Recently, with the Covid19 pandemic, curfews and the difficulties in controlling these bans have been taken into account and this system has been developed in order to reduce them. A study was conducted in which an e-mail can be sent to the authorized person or persons after the person with a diagnosis of Covid-19 registered in the data set in the system was viewed by the camera after he went out on the street. In the designed software, face recognition is performed first by detecting the face with the Haar-Cascades classifier and then using LBPH (Local Binary Patterns Histograms). This process is done by tagging each pixel of the introduced image by mapping it to other pixels around it. This labeling result is converted to binary number system and stored. It tries to recognize the face by comparing the images taken from the camera in real time with this number. In the classification process, if the person was previously registered in the data set, it is framed in "red" color. If the classification is not registered, it is enclosed in "green" colored frames. The purpose of this is to distinguish between a person with a diagnosis of Covid-19 and a healthy person. The success of the applications performed on the software was measured as 90% and the error as 10%.

• Accuracy Estimation and Analysis of the Model Developed on Faster R-Cnn Convolutional Neural Network with Deep Learning Methods: Object Detection Application

Deep learning, which hosts many subjects such as object recognition, image processing, and estimation, has become the need of human being day by day. In this study, object recognition is performed using deep learning techniques. The "Glass" dataset, which was developed using the Faster R-CNN (Faster Region Based Convolutional Networks) network and contains 502 images in the study, was created. One part of this data set was used for testing and the other part for training purposes. After observing in which ways he could recognize the glass by doing different experiments, suggestions were made on how to increase the accuracy estimation rate. An interface with web cam options where we can take photos, videos and instant images while doing object recognition has been designed. While designing the interface, the Tkinter library, a Python library, was used. If the image for which the object will be detected is a photograph, after the operations, the top of the object is











framed and a photograph is recorded with the correct guess at what percentage. If the image to be detected is a video, it will be written what percentage the object on the video is estimated in frame while the video is playing, while the web cam will keep the object in the image in the frame and display it on the screen. In this study, which was carried out using the Object Detection API, it was tried to train the model with different epoch values and find the epoch value that predicts with the most accurate ratio. It was carried out using deep learning and Faster R-CNN on the data set created on 18 different experiments. In order to find the most successful prediction rate in the training process, experiments were carried out with different epoch numbers. As a result of the total 100,000 epoch training, the success result is 0.97835 and the loss rate is 0.02165.

• Establishment of an Electronic Spraying/Irrigation System with a Hexacopter Unmanned Aerial Vehicle

In the thesis study, whose name is mentioned, a hexacopter that can provide autonomous flight with six rotors was created, and an automatic spraying or irrigation system adaptation designed in line with the created mechanism was carried out. In line with this integrated system, the data of the test flights carried out by the spraying or irrigation hexacopter, which can perform six-rotor flight, were obtained, and in the light of these data, it was stated that the result of the study was reached. In the created system, autopilot module (STM32F427 Cortex M4 core) is used to perform normal flight or autonomous flight. Thanks to this module used, AC motor controls in the system, processing of radio control signals and reading telemetry data are realized.

The software of the autopilot in the created system was implemented on the ArduPilot platform, and the most suitable parameters were determined on this platform in line with the tests carried out. In line with the determined parameters, all data during the flight can be monitored instantly via the radio control equipment, that is, the remote control. In addition, since Hexatar, which is integrated with the ArduPilot program, has sensors such as GPS, altimeter, and barometer, all data received from these sensors (position, altitude, direction of travel) can be followed on the ArduPilot program.

• Design, Analysis and Production of an Electric Jet Engine Air-to-Terrain Navigation Missile with the Help of a 3D Printer

With the development of unmanned aerial vehicles in recent years, many of the developed countries have started to replace the existing warplanes in their defense industry inventories with unmanned warplanes. New ammunition needs have arisen for unmanned aerial vehicles, which have just begun to enter the inventory of countries. The technical features of unmanned aerial vehicles, which are different from existing warplanes, prevent the use of existing ammunition. Especially the limited useful load carrying capacity and low cruising speed of these new aircraft make it necessary to produce new ammunition. In this thesis, a cruise missile design with a working system that can be compatible with the unmanned aerial vehicles in our country's inventory and which is not in the inventory of any country has been made.











The hull of this cruise missile was produced entirely by using a 3D printer. An electric fan motor is positioned to provide thrust to the cruise missile. In addition, fins powered by servo motors to determine direction and a flight controller to control these motors have also been added. The system works entirely with electrical energy. The battery feeding the main system and the safety button, a second battery powering the electronic equipment and a second safety switch are integrated into the fuselage of the missile. The body consists of 4 blocks and can be manually disassembled and reassembled without the need for any joining element.

- Design, Analysis and Production of a Bi-Axis Food Liquid Pouring Machine with and without Machining
- In the culinary arts, where people's talent is needed, it is aimed to reduce the workforce and reduce the error to zero with the help of technology. In this period, when 3-axis printers became widespread, machines that can print many materials instead of plastic are now produced. In the thesis, it is aimed to produce more serial and less faulty products by using a two-axis system in the food industry with this machine, without the need for work skills. In the first part of the thesis, literature review is included, in the second part, the design of the engine, liquid flow unit and mechanical part used in the system is included. In the third section, the software part is included, and in the fourth section, experimental tests of this designed machine with machining and chipless production were carried out. The working states of the coordinates (x, y) and the liquid flow unit sent by the computer interface in real time on the designed machine are processed with the microcontroller software. The software is discussed in two parts. It is a microcontroller software that will provide control by an interface in a computer environment and a computer interface created. The computer interface design was designed using the c# (c sahrp) language on the Visual Studio 2017 platform. Arduino software was also used in the design of the microcontroller software. The machine sends the drawings made with the mouse on the computer interface or the previously saved *.PANKEK file extension pancake data to the microcontroller from the serial port communication point where the microcontroller card is connected to the computer. According to the data in the incoming file, the mechanical structure with the pancake liquid reservoir activates the air pump and transmits the liquid towards the gate. It provides the desired shape to the user by transferring the liquid to the heated table in two axes by taking action with stepper motors. These operations are done with a card with an ATmega328 microcontroller. The mechanical structure of the machine has an arm movement on the first axis, linear bearing-bearing shafts, while the second axis has a casting mouth supported by a belt system. Compared to similar projects, its single-arm structure











provides convenience when taking and placing the heating plate and during intervention to the user.



• Test drives of the flying car 'Tusi', the construction of which was started in 2018 by Turkish engineers at the Technology Transfer Office (TTO) at Istanbul Gelisim University, began in the open field. The vehicle called 'Tusi' can be charged in 2.5 hours and stay in the air for 9 minutes. Links to the news in the press are given below.

- The project is one of the important projects of the Technology Transfer Office. Halis Kuralay, Deputy Provincial Director of the Ministry of Family and Social Policies, and his team came to visit the Technology Transfer Office and exchanged ideas and found the project successful.
- Both the disabled and normal people were interviewed for the relief guideways, and it was observed that they caused trips and falls on the walking paths. In addition, it was concluded that the probability of slipping increases on some roads in winter. The purpose of the invention is a system that will enable visually impaired people to find











their way more easily during their walks in order to do their daily work in indoor or outdoor areas. In this way, it is aimed that they can easily find their way without the need for the help of other people, thanks to the walking stick, which is laid on the ground without the danger of getting stuck on any relief on the ground. The possibility of slipping and falling can be completely eliminated by sticking an adhesive sandpaper surface on the magnetic sheet. With this project, participation has been shown in the Turkey with Patents competition organized by the Turkish Patent and Trademark Office.

• The machine and its software, which shapes the dough in 2 dimensions, are designed as a two-axis machine that provides drawing with edible dough on a computer-designed hot plate, and interface software that provides control. Designed with the desktop software written specifically for the machine, the drawing designed on the computer interface is poured into the cooking area using two axes and cooked. Personalized products increase their preference in today's service sector. The aim is to create a product in which, thanks to the interface and the machine, operators can offer a crepe of their own design to their customers. The first design was successfully implemented. It continues to be developed by adding new features.
