Gastronorm Laboratory



Department of Gastronomy and Culinary Arts utilize laboratories for the applied courses in the curriculum. Basic culinary techniques, Turkish and world cuisine, a la carte applications, pastry techniques, cooking methods courses are taught in Block B Gastronomy laboratory with a capacity of 55 students. With a rich supply of equipment and materials, students have the chance to put what they learn in theory into practice.



Gastronomy and Culinary Arts Laboratory



Department of Gastronomy and Culinary Arts utilize the laboratory for the applied courses in the curriculum. Pastry techniques, sauces and soups, bakery products, basic kitchen techniques, Turkish and world cuisine courses in the curriculum are taught in the Gastronomy and Culinary Arts laboratory in Block C with a capacity of 65 students. In this new department laboratory, which has a pastry area with rich products and equipment and ovens with different functional features unlike the gastronomy kitchen, students prepare themselves for the applications of gastronomy science.



Pilot Melike Kuvvet Hangar



There is a real Cessna model airplane in the Pilot Melike Kuvvet Airplane Hangar. Our students have the opportunity to experience the training they have seen in theoretical courses and reinforced in practical courses on a real airplane and its parts in the Pilot Melike Kuvvet Airplane Hangar. Although mainly mechanical studies are carried out in the hangar, partial avionic studies are also carried out. Our students have the opportunity to study many different subjects from riveting to engine troubleshooting in the hangar.



Simultaneous Interpreting Laboratory



In our Simultaneous Interpreting Laboratory, which was established in the 2022-2023 academic year as an educational infrastructure of our faculty, an environment is created where our students can perform both consecutive and simultaneous interpreting practices with a focus on oral translation. To this end, there are three booths in the laboratory that allow interpreting practice. Each of these booths allows two interpreters to interpret simultaneously in different language pairs.



Television Studio



Our Television Studio, located on the ground floor of Block B of our university, has an integrated structure used as a director, editing room and shooting area. Our students can perform both camera shooting techniques and single camera or multi-camera TV program shootings with or without a director in applied courses. While the studio area has a décor design for different types of program shootings, there are studio technical equipment such as intercom, SE2800 digital video switcher, playout, character generator and prompter.



Applied Communication Workshop



In the Applied Communication Workshop, trainings such as creative camera and shooting housing, sound and visual production research, lighting research and advertising/product use shooting are given using professional camera, sound and environmental equipment such as Sony A7SIII camera, Sony GMaster lens set, DJI Mavic 3 drone, Zoom H8 sound recorder and Falcon Eyes 800W light set in greenbox environment.



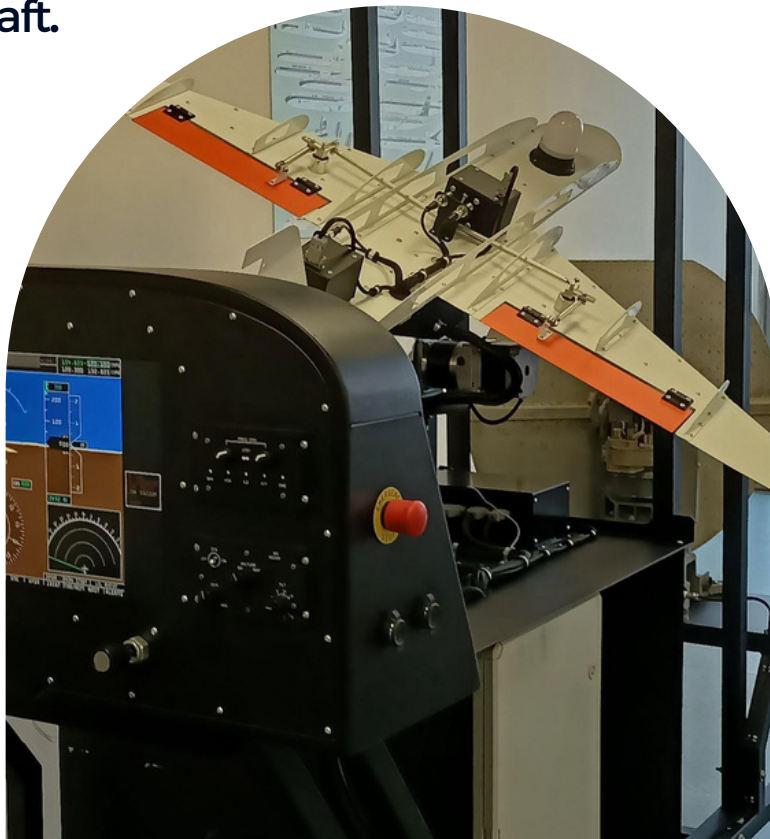
Aircraft Electronics/Avionics Laboratory

Aircraft Electronics/Avionics laboratory is used for students to grasp basic electronics, circuit analysis, logical circuits knowledge practically. Our students in this laboratory, oscilloscope, signal generator, avometer and so on. After receiving basic training on the use of digital devices, she also completes practical training on these devices. In addition, our 'Technical Trainer' instructors who teach in our laboratory have a lot of experience and expertise in their field.



Aircraft Avionic B2 Laboratory

The Aircraft Avionics B2 laboratory is the laboratory where knowledge and skills are gained and operations are carried out on the recognition of the basic electrical circuit elements for the aircraft, the detection of their malfunctions, the recognition of the aircraft electrical systems and components, the learning of the working principles, the learning of the aircraft electrical systematics. In addition, it is a workshop where basic aircraft electronics, digital and navigation system components are introduced, learning operating principles, troubleshooting and circuit monitoring skills for aircraft.



Aircraft Systems Laboratory I - II



In Aircraft Systems Laboratory, trainings are given on the introduction of landing gear, turbine fuel and flight control systems of aircraft systems, teaching the working principles and functioning; disassembly and repair of defective units.



Aircraft Engine Laboratory I - II



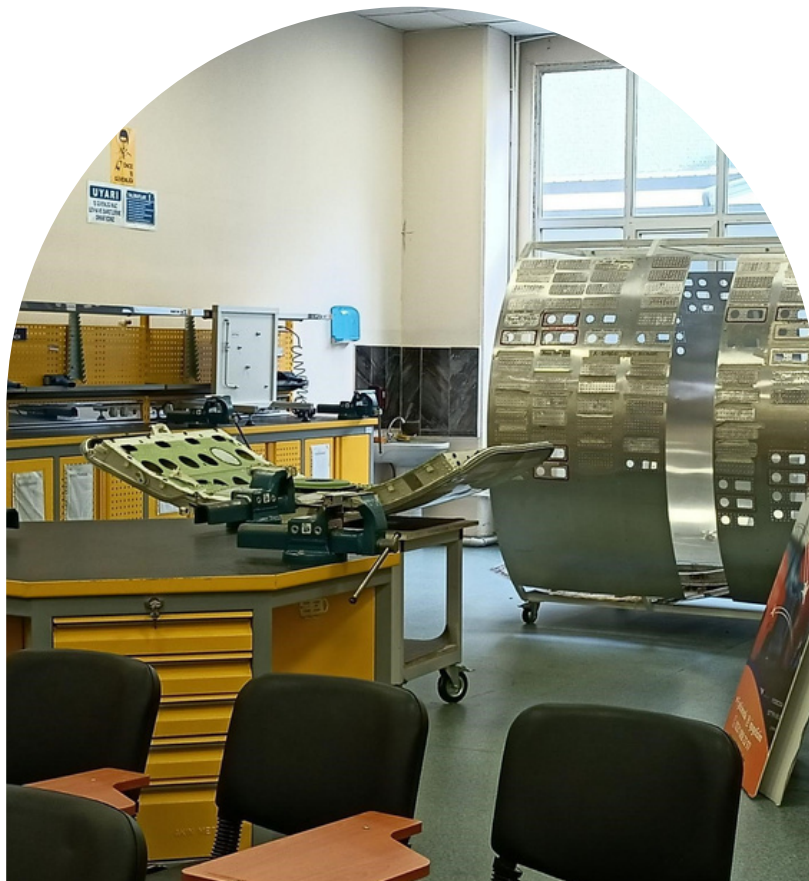

Aircraft Structural/ Mechanical Laboratory I - II



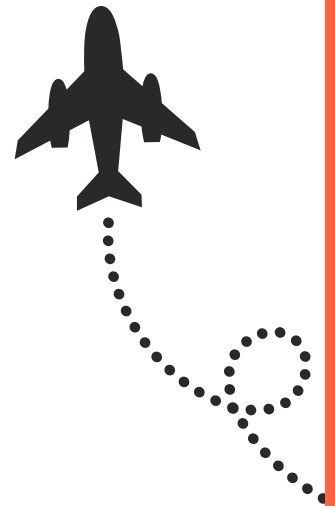
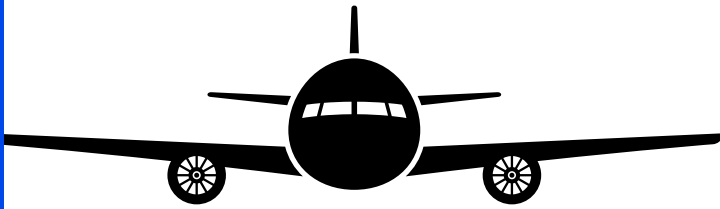

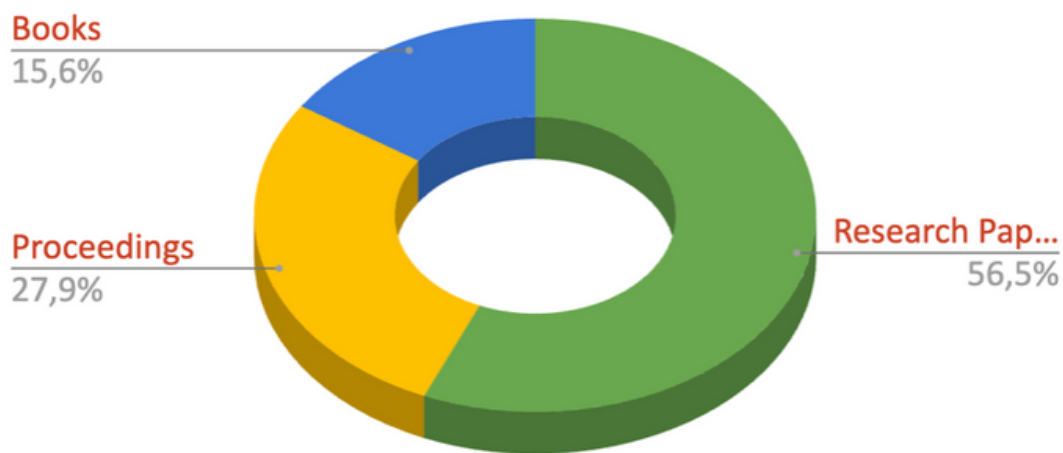

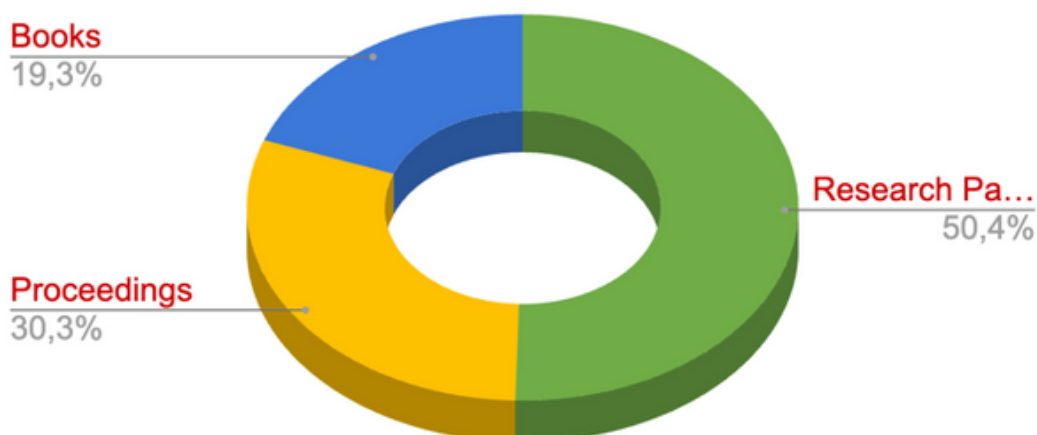

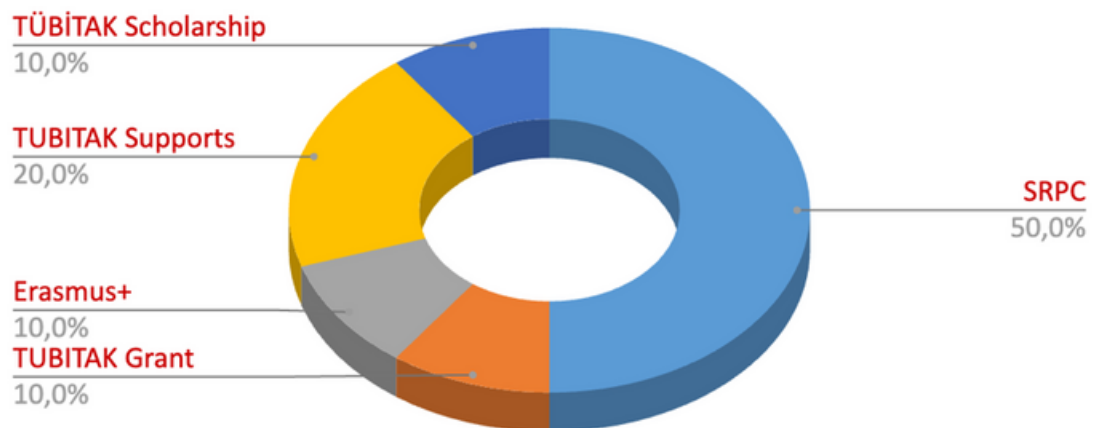
**TOTAL NUMBER OF ACADEMIC PUBLICATIONS

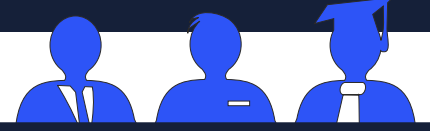

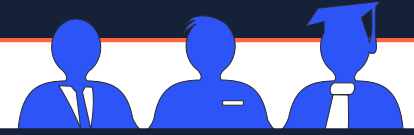
INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF APPLIED SOCIAL SCIENCES - USBK

Digital Entrepreneurship and Electronic Commerce Club

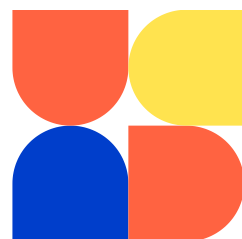

Aircraft Maintenance Club

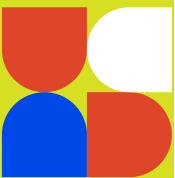
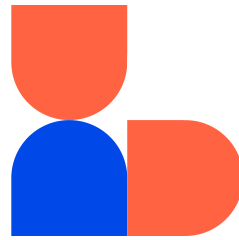

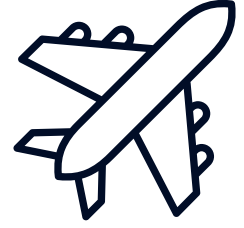

- To contribute to the personal development and socialization of students.

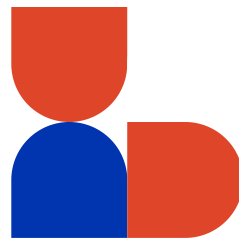

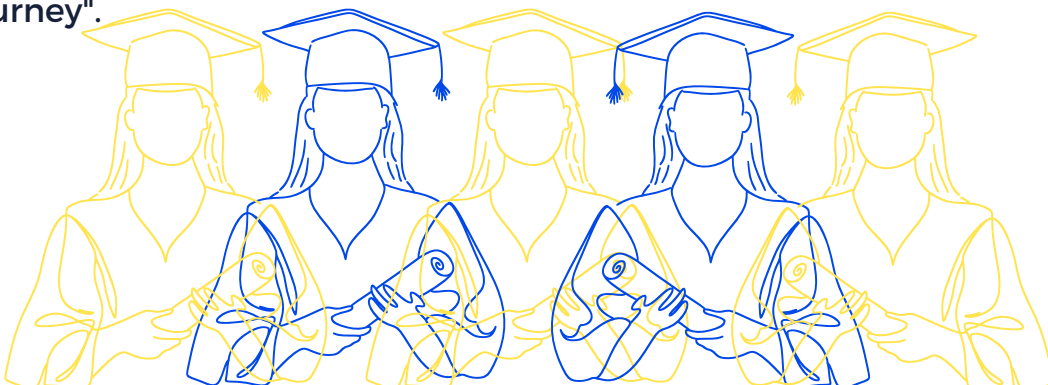
I chose my department because I wanted to be an advertising copywriter.
