






"On The Bizce Istanbul Project: How We Started, What Are We Doing?" Interview was Held




Interior Architecture and Interior Architecture and Environmental Design Departments Meet with Candidate Students at Istanbul **Gelişim University Promotion Days**




Interview with SOZOP Team and Psychologist Serpil Büyükbaş Titled

Lecturer Yusuf Taner Gültekin was the Guest of the Talks with the "Building Catalogue | 8x8 Architect & Material Series" Concept



Assistant Professor Aysun Cançat's Manifesto Titled "About to Artwork Sale in Current Times" was Published



An interview was held with Emre Doğan, Assistant Professor of Radio, Television and Cinema at Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) Faculty of Fine Arts (GSF), about his academic career and artistic works.

Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) Faculty of Fine Arts (GSF) Radio, Television and Cinema Department Assistant Professor Emre Doğan answered questions about his academic career, artistic works and new term planning.

Let's get to know you briefly. When and how did you decide to become an academic?

My name is Emre Doğan, I am 30 years old and originally from Erzurum. I completed my undergraduate, graduate and doctorate education at Ege University and Dokuz Eylul University in Izmir. My curiosity about meaning and knowledge production led me to academics. Therefore, I can say that I want to be an academician from a very young age.

Could you give information about your academic and sectoral studies? In which areas and subjects will you have studies/projects in the next period?

Academically, I work on the relationship between cinema and philosophy, the relationship between philosophy of science and science fiction, and the genre of short films. In the sectoral sense, I am directing, scriptwriting and executive producer of short films, documentaries and clips. I will continue to be at the festivals with the new projects that I have recently produced and the new short films I have sent to the General Directorate of Cinema for support.

What would you like to say to the new students who will be included in our university and department at the beginning of the new term, about the field of Radio, Television and Cinema?

The field of Radio, Television and Cinema is a sectorally challenging and yet eye-opening field in which students who set their sights on this business must always improve themselves. Students who will start to study in this field should always be open to self-development and have a perspective and understanding that invests in their audio-visual and linguistic abilities. This understanding is extremely important for the graduates of the school to make their name heard in the sector and to reach the position they aim for.

Can you tell us about your plans for the new term within the faculty or department, as well as for your own courses?

This year, the theoretical and practical courses are intertwined, the theoretical knowledge is supported by practice; I prepared/we prepared a program full of visuality, scenario, fiction and cinema philosophy.

We have planned/planned lessons with important curricula that will contribute to the visual, auditory and intellectual selfdevelopment of the students of our department and actually build this subject on a solid foundation. My main aim is to comprehend the cinema theoretically and practically.

We would like to thank Assistant Professor Emre Doğan for answering our questions.

You have successfully completed the 3rd grade, how was this semester completed with distance education for you?

I can say that the distance education process was fruitful for me. Articles, videos, etc. my instructors supported the lessons with various contents. I think it's mutual interaction. Online education should not be preferred in the normal education process, but due to the increase in the epidemic, I think that I can get enough efficiency from my school and instructors when we switch to online education.

Has the distance education process contributed positively to you? What did you do to improve yourself during this process?

Because I like to research and read, I have reviewed various contents and read articles. I have had different experiences. I used materials on the Internet. I also developed myself during the internship process.

You have been away from both your school and your friends and teachers during the distance education process, what did you miss the most during this process?

I am a person with good communication and bilateral relations. That's why I miss my friends and teachers so much. I missed participating in social events, taking

part in projects and studies. I miss taking notes while listening to the lecture in the front row. I miss analyzing and discussing different points of view. I needed face-to-face communication.

You completed your compulsory internship this summer. Can you tell us about your industry experiences during the internship process?

My internship went very well and was very productive. I was worried that I would be alienated from my profession because of the approach of the people I would meet during my internship, but it did not work out as I was worried, I got very good results. I met nice people with whom I kept in touch after my internship was over. The work I did during my internship and the people I knew gave me a lot. I communicated not only with people working in my department, but also with people working in other parts of the hotel. I also experienced the patisserie, a la carte and hot sections. When I started my internship, I didn't want the cold section, but luckily I was assigned to the cold section. Now I am very glad that I have gained experience in the cold department and I offer myself the option to continue my career in the cold department. I can say that the most important thing is that I gained speed and order in the internship. I can control the kitchen. I can make a schedule. I also





had the chance to visit the kitchen of Kocaeli University.

How do you plan to direct your career after

How do you plan to direct your career after graduation, can you tell us about your goals?

I think a lot about this and I worry about the future. I talk to my friends, business owners and professors about how to progress after graduation. I am a person who is open to sharing and conveys his knowledge and experience, so I aim to be an instructor from the first year of university. After graduating from my undergraduate degree, I want to complete my master's degree at Istanbul Gelişim University and cook in this sector. Then I offer myself the option of being a trainer. I plan to be an owner chef in the future. I want to evaluate my own recipes and presentations, design a place outside the known and develop different tastes.

What advice would you give to your friends who are new to our department?

First of all, I can say that they took the right step because they chose Istanbul Gelişim University. I think that our trainers are sufficient and successful in terms of practice and theory. I can say that our courses are supported by various content and are efficient. We can establish social communication with our instructors outside of the classroom. I also recommend that they

join our school's clubs; in this way, they have experience in projects and events. I took part in some associations by participating in the activities of my school. I recommend that they get support from the books in our library regarding course content. They should not limit themselves to only the information on the internet, they can access various resources in our school. There were articles, magazines, books, movies and documentaries suggested to us by my instructors, and I followed them, researched and read them. This has helped me a lot. Be sure to take into account the suggestions of our instructors, at the end of the road you will say that you have read and watched two good times. I also think that they should take initiatives such as producing content on social media. Because now our profession attracts a lot of attention on social media. Finally, I recommend that they consult with our trainers for their personal development and how they will follow after graduation.





As the first step of the lifelong learning process, Istanbul Gelişim University Fine Arts Faculty Interior Architecture Department aims to train interior architects who can produce efficient, original, sustainable, new concepts, furniture and designs by transferring the professional cultural and social knowledge they have acquired since the beginning of their language education. For this purpose, the curriculum has been formed at a level that will enable them to have a successful career with theoretical and practical courses and compulsory summer internships. For this purpose, the Department of Interior Architecture provides the acquisition of the artistic skills and perspective required for the interior architecture profession through intensive drawing lessons from the beginning of the undergraduate education. Then, with computer aided drawing programs, it is ensured that sufficient gains to meet their professional needs are obtained.

Drawing is a language of expression for the Interior Architecture profession. In our department, our students are provided with the opportunity to acquire this language of expression necessary for their professional life, after the start of their undergraduate education, with our intensive applied curriculum from the first grade. With the accreditation process, our curriculum has been arranged in a way that will enable them to become well-equipped interior architects who can use all the drawing methods necessary for their professional life, by adapting to today's conditions, having a good command of computer-

aided drawing programs, so drawing ability is not an obstacle for the Department of Interior Architecture.

In our department, in addition to compulsory applied courses such as Basic Art Education, Visual Expression, Interior Design Studies, Interior Architecture Studio, Furniture and Graduation Project, there are also applied courses from many different disciplines in the elective pool.

In addition, in the Elective Course Pool; Smart Buildings, Mobile Living Units, History of Architecture and Interior Architecture, History of Urbanism and Urban Planning, Advanced Graphic Expression Techniques, Environment of the Future, Professional Practices, Universal Design, Project Management and Cost, Survey, Urban Analysis of Istanbul, Lighting Technologies, Aesthetics And Creativity, Concept And Design, Color And Its Use In Interior Architecture, Showcase And Fair Stand Design, Advanced Visual Expression Techniques, Interior Textiles, Conservation Restoration, Construction Site Management, Acoustics, Design And Branding, Future Materials, Interior Architecture Professional Practices. With the vocational elective courses of the Interior Architecture and Interior Architecture Environmental Design Departments, the opportunity to develop in the fields of interest is provided. Due to the fact that the elective course pool is created jointly with the other departments of the Faculty of Fine Arts, it is also possible to turn to courses that will feed different areas of interest without any conditions.





What Awaits the Candidates?



What Features Should I Consider When Choosing A University?

It should be questioned whether there are opportunities for Erasmus and similar foreign exchange programs at the selected school.

If the choice of school will be made in the city of residence, the proximity of the school to the house or the difficulty of transportation are important criteria for the student to have a healthy education process.

The studios of the school and its tendency towards scientific research are one of the important factors to be considered.

If there is an internship obligation in your branch, the opportunities provided by the school regarding internship should be examined.

Information about the seminars and congresses organized by the school should be obtained, and information should be taken about similar event opportunities that will contribute to cultural and personal development.

Before choosing a school, the student candidates should ask themself which profession they want, and

choose a profession that they can continue in their life for a long time.

In order to be more successful, the students should choose a department that they can perform with great pleasure.

If possible, you should go and visit the branch you want to attend, in case the university is located on a different campus outside the known center.

It would be beneficial to meet and talk with the academic staff of the relevant department. By doing this, it is possible to have an idea about whether the education given reflects the requirements of the age apart from the theory.

Due to the university education does not only consist of theoretical education in the classroom environment, the social facilities, sports facilities, library and clubs of the school should also be investigated, these are very important for the personal development of the student.


