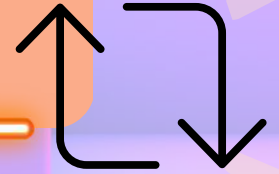

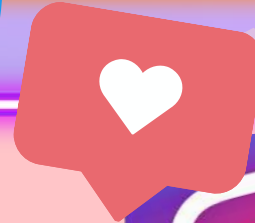
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ISTANBUL GELISIM UNIVERSITY IS 16TH IN THE WORLD AND 1ST IN TURKEY IN THE FIELD OF "QUALITY EDUCATION"!

Times Higher Education (THE), the ranking institution of world universities, has been announced the Impact Ranking of 2022. Among the 1180 universities in the world, Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) increased its success ranking, which was 24 last year, to 16th place in the category of "Quality Education" by increasing 8 steps this year. It continued to maintain its success last year, ranking 1st among Turkish universities.

The success of Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) was ranked in five different categories in line with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, in the list of 1406 universities, which are listed in the 2022 ranking of the UK-based, world's leading higher education rating agency, Times Higher Education (THE). In the Impact Ranking 2022 list, Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) increased its degree from 24th to 16th among 1180 world universities in the "Quality Education" category, while maintaining its 1st place among Turkish universities.

5 ACHIEVEMENTS FROM 5 DIFFERENT CATEGORIES

In the ranking carried out in line with the categories in 17 fields determined by the United Nations within the scope of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG), Istanbul Gelisim University is among the universities of Turkey, with its studies in the field of education, innovative projects and its contributions to the society;

- SDG4: Ranked 1st in Turkey in the Quality Education category,
- SDG7: Ranked 4th in Turkey in Accessible and Clean Energy category,
- SDG3: Ranked 12th in Turkey in the category of Healthy and Quality Life,
- SDG6: Ranked 12th in Turkey in the category of Clean Water and Sanitation
- SDG17: Ranked 24th in Turkey in the Partnerships for Purposes category, it proved itself in many areas such as lifelong learning practices, community-oriented learning, personal development opportunities, quality and sustainability of the education provided.

COMPLEMENTARY HEALTH INSURANCE

Complementary health insurance is a type of insurance in which individuals subject to the Social Security Institution (SGK) can use private health insurance and social security insurance together. Private health insurances that provide outpatient and inpatient treatment by many people are costly. In order to solve this problem, complementary health insurance covers the treatment fees that are not covered by the SSI or the difference fees arising from the treatments that are covered by the hospitals that have an agreement with the SGK.

Anyone who has general health insurance between the ages of 0-80 can take out complementary health insurance. The prerequisite for obtaining complementary health insurance is to have an active general health insurance. If the general health insurance of the insured is not active or does not exist, the insured can benefit from the benefits of complementary health insurance by paying his/her premiums from outside. In other words, those who want to have complementary health insurance must pay premiums both to the insurance company for private health and to SGK for general health insurance.



Complementary health insurance in our country is valid only in hospitals contracted with SGK. For this reason, people who plan to receive treatment in hospitals that are not contracted with SSI for certain diseases or who do not want to be subject to institution or doctor limitations in the treatment they will receive should pay attention to this practice. With the participation of SGK, which is available in the supplementary health insurance, treatment costs can be reduced and private health insurance premiums can be lowered, thus providing this opportunity to people who cannot obtain private health insurance due to high premiums.

All complementary health insurance products; It consists of inpatient treatment coverage and outpatient treatment coverage. In addition, in case of an accident or illness, support can be obtained from complementary health insurances in the emergency services of private hospitals.

Inpatient treatment coverage is the coverage that covers hospitalization and treatment expenses as well as emergency expenses in cases requiring hospitalization for not less than 24 hours. Inpatient treatment coverage becomes active 3 months after the policy start date. In case of inpatient treatment before 3 months, the insurance company does not cover any costs. However, if the insured is injured as a result of an emergency or accident, if the hospital is entered from the red zone, the waiting period loses its importance and the insurance company covers all the costs.



Outpatient treatment coverage is a limited coverage. Outpatient treatment limit, which varies according to the insurance company; may consist of 6 or 10 doctor's examinations per year. Each examination also covers all diagnostic procedures, analyzes and examinations.

Medication costs are not covered by supplemental health insurance. Therefore, supplementary health insurance does not cover medication costs. However, since the insured is covered by SSI, a certain part of most drugs is covered by the state. On the basis of insurance company; Ambulance, surgery, pre- and post-operative examination, intensive care, chemotherapy, radiotherapy, dialysis and medical observation costs are unlimited. However, home care, artificial limb, medical equipment, physical therapy and rehabilitation expenses are covered by insurance companies to a limited extent.

ELECTRICAL HOME APPLIANCES AND TECHNOLOGIES

Electrical household appliances are indispensable devices that we use in our homes. Today, their use has become much more widespread with the developing technology. They are products that make our lives easier, used in many rooms such as the kitchen, bathroom and balcony. Iron, toaster, hair dryer, electric oven, electric stove, electric heater, refrigerator, washing machine, dishwasher, vacuum cleaner and many other products can be given as examples.

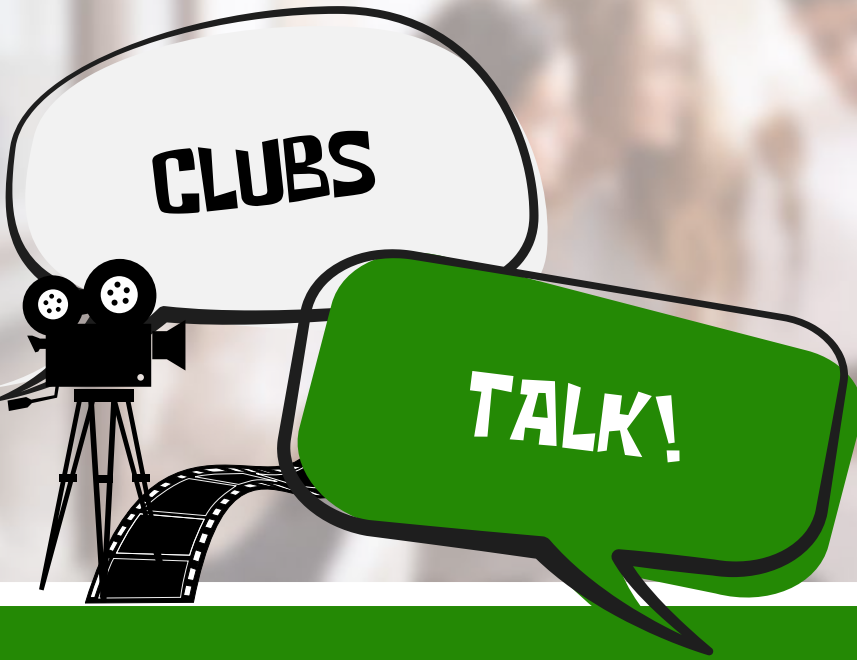


Many of these devices are similar to each other in terms of working principle. In heated tools, resistance is used as a heating element and a thermostat is used to limit the temperature. Iron, toaster, hair dryer, electric heater can be given as examples of such tools. Another type is power tools. Appliances such as vacuum cleaner, rondo, mixer, blender are also included in this group. A motor that provides movement and a speed control controller, which we call a dimmer, is used to control the speed of the motor.



There are also devices with both heaters and motors, which are a mixture of these two categories. Devices such as washing machine, dishwasher, tumble dryer are also included in this group. Although each has its own production method, it is actually the most difficult iron to work in production. Although electrically it consists of only the resistor (heating element), the thermostat and the wiring harness, the iron is made up of too many small or large parts. Steam system, shock steam system, water spray function, self-cleaning feature called anti-calcium, anti-dripping feature, and automatic shut-off feature found in some irons require the use of many materials and greatly increases labor. Therefore, we can say that although the iron looks smaller, it has more parts than the toaster.

Although the structure of electrical appliances may seem simple, there is actually a lot of technical information in the background. For example, UFO brand once released an electric heater called infrared heater and gained a large share in the market. Seeing this, other manufacturers tried to produce a similar product at a more affordable price. It didn't take much investment to produce the infrared heater. Since the main body is aluminum extrusion, it is taken ready. The heater tube is taken ready, the thermostat is ready, almost everything is ready. It remains only to put the pieces together. It came to such a situation that the cyclist quit his bicycle business and produced this heater, and the owner of the market started the production of this product. Many people who do not have technical knowledge in this business have tried to manufacture this product. However, due to lack of technical knowledge, when poor quality and inadequate components were used to be cheap, the products started to malfunction and many manufacturers had to collect their products from the market. Therefore, many of them went bankrupt and they could not make their payments to the companies from which they bought materials, leaving the market in a difficult situation. As in every field, technical knowledge is very important in the production of electrical household appliances. Although it may seem simple, there are many details in the background.



Our club, keeping in mind the technological advances; It was established to provide students with experience in the field of photography and video shooting, to make applications and to share the work done with both our university and our external stake holders. The photography and video clubs, which organize many events with the guests of the sector employees, also ensure that the students have an idea about the sector with the experiences conveyed by the guests.

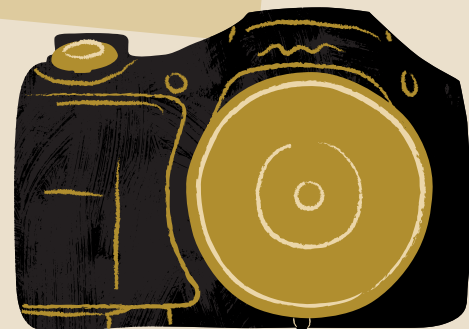

THINGS TO KNOW

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ABOUT NEW CORONAVIRUS



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All necessary measures are taken for the **coronavirus** revealed in Turkey and the World at **Istanbul Gelisim University**. **Things to know about coronavirus are as follows:**

What are the new coronavirus symptoms?

- The most common symptoms are **fever, cough and respiratory distress**.
- In severe cases, **pneumonia, severe respiratory failure, kidney failure and death** may occur
- Incubation period is between **2 and 14 days**.

How is the virus transmitted?

- It can be transmitted by the contact of the droplets caused by **coughing and sneezing** with the contact of the **mouth, nose and eyes** of other individuals in certain environment and by touching the surfaces where the droplets adhere and taking hands **into the mouth, nose or eyes**.

What to do to be protected from the virus?

- When **coughing or sneezing**, the mouth and nose should be covered with a **disposable tissue**, if there is no handkerchief, the mouth should be closed with the **upper sleeve or elbow**, not with the palms.
- **Handshaking and hugging** should be avoided.
- **Mouth, nose and eyes** should not be touched with dirty hands.
- Hands must be washed for **at least 20 seconds** in accordance with the **Handwashing Instructions** found in the toilets. In the absence of water and soap, **alcohol-containing hand antiseptics** should be used. **Cologne of 70-80 degrees** also serve as disinfectants.
- Offices and classrooms must be **ventilated hourly**.
- Places frequently used by many people such as common areas and door handles should be **disinfected every 2 hours**.
- Hands **must be washed** after using **public transportation**.
- Because the virus progresses faster in people with low immune system; **a balanced and healthy diet** is required. Foods **must be washed thoroughly** before consumption.

What to do if there are symptoms?

- If you have come from countries with infections **in the past 14 days**, apply to the **nearest healthcare facility** by wearing a **surgical mask**.
- If you are **coughing, have a fever and have difficulty at breathing**, apply to the **nearest healthcare facility** by wearing a **surgical mask**.
- **Always wear your mask** when you are in the same room with **a person who is recommended insulation** at home.
