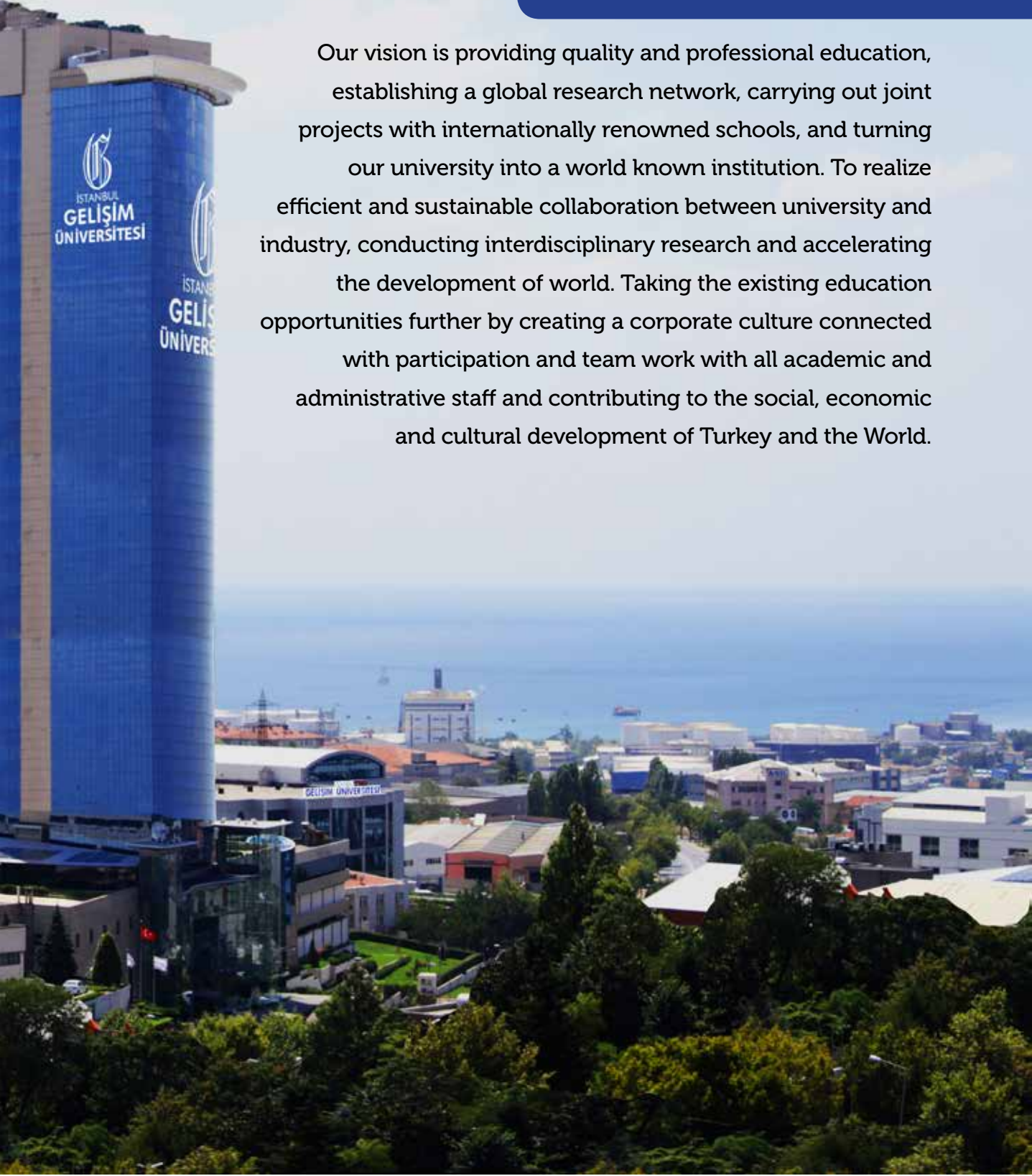
OUR MISSION

HOW TO BECOME A MEMBER OF GELISIM

Student Acceptance via OSYM

For the undergraduate and associate degree programs of the students, with the scores of Higher Education Transfer Examination (YGS) or Undergraduate Placement Examination (LYS); graduates from the Associate Degree Programs are placed in İstanbul Gelisim University by ÖSYM to their undergraduate programs with the scores of Undergraduate Transfer Examination (DGS)

Admission of Students with Special Talent Examination

Students must have received at least 150 raw points from any point type of Higher Education Transfer Examination (YGS) for the programs that require the talent examination and must be successful as a result of the talent examination conducted by İstanbul Gelisim University.

Admission of Students with External Transfer Examination

Students who attend External Transfer Examination will be placed by OSYM if they obtain the necessary score. Any student from associate degree programs of İstanbul Gelisim University will receive 50 % scholarship if they are placed by DGS.

Admission of Foreign Students

Provided they are in the final year of high school or are in graduation; 1) Those who are foreign nationals; and 2) Those who are Turkish citizens at birth and who are granted permission to leave the Turkish nationality from the Ministry of the Interior and who have documentary evidence of the use of the Recognized Rights of minors registered under the Turkish Citizenship Act in accordance with





the Turkish Citizenship Act (Turkish numbered 5901) 7 "(1) The Turkish citizen who is born in marriage union with mother or father in Turkey is a Turkish citizen." it is beneficial for candidates who will apply for quotas from abroad to examine

the Turkish Citizenship Law. 3) Those who were foreign nationals but became citizens of Turkish Republic / and those with double nationalities under this status 4) a) Those who are Turkish citizens who were enrolled in secondary education abroad before 01/02/2013, who have completed the last three years of secondary education (high school) in a foreign country (except for Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus) b) Those who are citizens of the Republic of Turkey after the date of 01/02/2013, candidates who started secondary education abroad will be able to apply for the full quota of secondary education (high school) to the acceptance quota of foreign students from abroad, including those who have completed secondary education (high school), including those who have completed Turkish schools which were opened in MEB in a foreign country other than TRNC. Those who complete in a foreign country other than the TRNC (including those who completed all of the secondary education (high school) in the Turkish schools opened in a foreign country other than TRNC), 5) TRNC citizens; applicants who have GCEAL exam results who have resided in the TRNC and have completed secondary education



(high school) in the TRNC and those who have obtained and trained GCE AL exam results and enrolled in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005 and 2010 are accepted. Applications from other candidates will not be accepted.

Medium of instruction depends on departments; Turkish, 30 % English and 100 % English. Students who have succeeded in the English Proficiency Exam at the beginning of the academic year for 30% and 100% English departments or those who have proved successful in one of the UDS, KPDS, YDS, TOEFL, IELTS, ESOL, (FCE), CAE and CPE exams accepted by the University to be equivalent are exempted from the preparatory program and they can directly be registered at the university department.



MINOR PROGRAM

Only the achievement certificate (minor certificate) is issued in the area where they have received training in the minor programs. The student may apply to the minor program earliest by the third semester and latest by sixth semester of undergraduate program. Students who have successfully completed all credited courses in the undergraduate program may apply to the minor program until the semester they are applying for. General average must be at least 2.50 above 4.0 Students who have obtained the right to graduate from the major program but can not finish the minor program are granted a maximum of two additional semesters with the decision of the relevant board of directors.

DOUBLE MAJOR

The aim of the Double Major Program is to ensure that students who have mastered their undergraduate major programs successfully receive a free undergraduate degree from a second major simultaneously. Students whose general grade point average in the program is 2.72 out of 4.00 and who have reached the 20 % success rate in their undergraduate program can be enrolled in the second major degree program free of charge. Student may apply to the second major program at the beginning of the third semester at the earliest of the major program, at the beginning of the fifth semester at the latest in four-year programs, and at the beginning of the seventh semester in five-year programs. In order to be able to start a double major program, the student must have successfully completed all the courses he / she has taken in the major program until the semester the second major program begins. Two undergraduate diplomas are awarded to students who have successfully completed their double major program and are eligible for two undergraduate degrees. The student who completes the second major program is given the diploma of the program only if he / she graduates from the main program in which he / she has attended.

100 % Scholarship (Full Scholarship)

Scholarships provided for students placed in scholarship programs include only tuition fees. Apart from that, there are other things like accommodation, meals, transportation, books and so on and they are not included within the scope of scholarship. Scholarships are non-refundable and will not be canceled during normal education. For those who have exceeded the normal training period and those who have received disciplinary actions, a decision will be given by Gelisim University Executive Board Decision whether the scholarship will continue or not.



75 % Scholarship

Students who have been placed to 75 % Scholarship programs by OSYM will pay the annual education fees with 75 % discount. Scholarships are non-refundable and will not be canceled during normal education. For those who have exceeded the normal training period and those who have received disciplinary actions, a decision will be given by Gelisim University Executive Board Decision whether the scholarship will continue or not.

50 % SCHOLARSHIP

Students who have been placed to 50 % Scholarship programs by OSYM will pay the annual education fees with 50 % discount. Scholarships are non-refundable and will not be canceled during normal education. For those who have exceeded the normal training period and those who have received disciplinary actions, a decision will be given by Gelisim University Executive Board Decision whether the scholarship will continue or not.

25 % SCHOLARSHIP

Students who have been placed to 25 % Scholarship programs by OSYM will pay the annual education fees with 25 % discount. Scholarships are non-refundable and will not be canceled during normal education. For those who have exceeded the normal training period and those who have received disciplinary actions, a decision will be given by Gelisim University Executive Board Decision whether the scholarship will continue or not.

PREFERENCE SCHOLARSHIP

Students who have preferred any department of Gelisim University (with fees) as the top 5 preference will obtain 30 % discount scholarship and they will pay the annual education fee with 30 % discount. For those who have exceeded the normal training period and those who have received disciplinary actions, a decision will be given by Gelisim University Executive Board Decision whether the scholarship will continue or not.



ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

Istanbul Gelisim University rewards our successful students with the Achievement Scholarship during the education period. In addition, scholarships are provided to our successful students whose financial status is inadequate, as determined by the Board of Trustees.



If more than one sibling is enrolled at our university, a discount of 5% will be applied to each sibling. This discount will be valid during the education period.

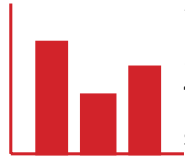

Students enrolled in YGS-LYS by earning the scholarship programs of our university in order;



Grade Scholarship



* 2,500TL for the first 10 * 2,000TL for the first 100 * 1,500TL for the first 500 * 1,000 TL for the first 1000.

This scholarship does not cover students who are placed with a Language score. "GRADE SCHOLARSHIP" is paid for 9 months. Except absenteeism, failure and disciplinary punishment; this is valid for 2 years for unlimited associate degree programs, 4 years for undergraduate programs.

R&D Incentive Scholarship

At İstanbul Gelisim University, scholarships are given to students who have implemented innovative, worldwide projects.

International Baccalaureate (IB) Support Scholarship

Students with International Baccalaureate (IB) diploma are 100% scholarship students.

* Scholarships provided for students placed in scholarship programs include only tuition fees. Apart from that, there are other things like accommodation, meals, transportation, books and so on and they are not included within the scope of scholarship. Scholarships are non-refundable and will not be canceled during normal education. It is decided whether or not to continue the scholarship with the decision of the University Administrative Board for the ones who exceed the normal education period and the disciplinary penalty areas. The tuition scholarship mentioned here includes only those students who have been placed in the programs specified in this guide for scholarship students.



ENGLISH PREPARATORY PROGRAM

Istanbul Gelisim University students need to master English at a level sufficient for them to enroll at departments teaching in English. The purpose of the English Preparatory Program is to give IGU students the necessary language skills to be successful in their academic life and to be able to express themselves in different settings where English is used as a means of communication.

* Students whose level of English language proficiency is below the level of associate degree and undergraduate programs will attend to the English Preparatory Program until they are able to do so. Students are placed at these levels according to the score they receive from the English Placement Exam at the beginning of the academic year.

* The program is compatible with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), which is used to describe the language skills of students around the world, and is designed to allow students who do not speak any English at the lowest level to complete in an academic year.

IGU-WEEKEND SCHOOL

There is a "Weekend School" application free of charge for English Preparatory Class students at Istanbul Gelisim University, School of Foreign Languages. The aim of the program is to improve the English speaking and communication skills of preparatory class students. Classes are organized on Saturdays to reduce cognitive barriers by removing the stress created by the classroom environment and to provide a fluent conversational habit in a more relaxed and confident environment.

Weekend School reduces the foreign language conversation shyness by transforming the formal relationship between the teacher and the student into a warmer and more intimate peer relationship, enabling students to speak more fluently in a natural and comfortable environment.

The refreshments given before and during the lessons motivate foreign communication to continue outside the classroom. Short conversations made in small groups with foreign lecturers who do not speak Turkish provide enrichment before, during and after class.

In the afternoon, Occupational English event is realized with IGU- Weekend School. Students are required to be familiar with the topics and words they will encounter in occupational courses at their departments. Students are preparing for the first time in the fields of Architecture, Engineering, Health, Psychology, Management, Commerce and Political Science with expert foreign lecturers. IGU students make a good start with their self-confidence at the Weekend School. Weekend School continues throughout the education period.

A "certificate of attendance" is provided for those students who regularly attend the program.

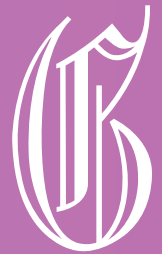

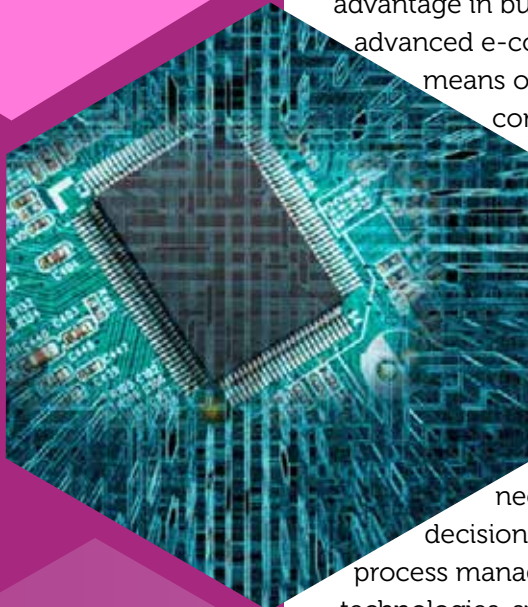

Courses and Contents History of Civilization (All Faculties)

The aim of this course is to help our students to learn about civilization, culture, cultural transformation, social structure and similar issues both in a global perspective and in compliance with our national values. The achievements of the course will enable our students to understand the changes and transformations in the History of Civilization that have taken place in the perspective of globalization and the history of Civilization until the emergence of the Information Society so that they can reason with greater confidence in global and national matters and explain their views on every platform.

Ethics (All Faculties)

The aim of this course is to provide our students with awareness and competence in ethical

reasoning and methods. The achievements of the course are to improve our students on the priority issues such as the origins of the concept of ethics, the concept of reasoning, Ethical Institutions and Rules in Turkey and social structure, and to improve their competencies in the fields of Science, Research and Technology Ethics, Business and Administration Ethics, Health Ethics, Political Ethics, Economic Ethics, Sustainability and Environmental Ethics.

Aesthetic Evaluation and Interpretation (IISBF, MMF, SBYO)

The aim of this course is to provide our students with awareness and competence in Aesthetic Evaluation and Interpretation beyond their professional knowledge and experience. The aim of the course is to give students the competences to make comments about the Aesthetics, Ideal, Beauty, Literature, Traditional and Fine Arts in terms of Aesthetics, Perception and Interpretation.

Critical and Creative Thinking (IISBF, MMF, SBYO)

The aim of this course is to provide awareness and competence in critical and creative thinking to our students. Acquisitions of the course is to provide the students with knowledge and competence in matters such as critical thinking, creative environments and ecosystems, idea visualization and similar aspects.

Science Fiction (All Faculties)

The aim of this course is to give our students a perspective on the concept of Science Fiction. The acquisitions of the course are to provide the students with knowledge and competence in Science Fiction classics such as Jules Verne, Asimov etc. and cults of Science Fiction such as Star Trek, Star Wars, E.T., Dune and case studies.

Laboratory of Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences INTERDISCIPLINARY STUDIES LABORATORIES

Noninvasive Brain Stimulation Laboratory

In this laboratory, which is hosting the joint researches in other parts of the psychology department, it is investigating the location of sensory and perceptual tasks in the cognitive and psycho-physiological areas of the human brain and investigating the responses in different qualities.

Non-Invasive Brain Stimulation Laboratory uses three dimensional modeling of the human brain which is unique for each person. By stimulating the brain region with the help of the magnetic field, stimulus-specific responses can be obtained. As a result of these answers, the activity of the localizations belonging to the brain regions can be examined by determining the brain webs involved in the participant mechanisms searched.

In addition, studies are being carried out in this laboratory on neuro-economics, cognitive psychology and neurological diseases. The physical infrastructure of the laboratory is equipped with the necessary equipment for MRI data analysis, transcranial magnetic stimulation and electro-stimulation. Our laboratory is in the phase of installation.



Child Development Ecologies Child and Family Studies Laboratory



In the Child and Family Studies Laboratory, child and family development projects are carried out with the work of undergraduate and graduate students. In these laboratories, cognitive, social and emotional developments of children are investigated in computer environment and by using scales. In addition, studies are carried out with experimental, observational and other methods to study the effects of child and family and environment interaction. The scales formed in these laboratories will play an important role in investigating social and mental effects in preschool, child development and family studies.

Culture (e.g. psychological consequences of cultural-family-self relationships, social and cultural change processes, intercultural comparative social psychology) - Group Dynamics and Group Relations (e.g. social identity, psychological foundations of prejudices towards various subgroups)- Social Cognitive (e.g. factors affecting the impressions we make about the individuals, mental representations of close relationships, social behavior and mental processes affecting decision making) are the issues being examined.

Mental development between 24-36 months, especially the development of working memory and its language development - Thinking processes (mind theory in children) - Children's language acquisition processes - Development of pre-school social and emotional skills, identification of risk groups and skill development programs for those groups are implemented. Our laboratory is in the phase of installation.

Timing, Memory and Decision Making Laboratory

In the Timing, Memory and Decision Making Laboratory, the timing and risk taking, decision-making behavior and memory-focused work carried out with people in the field of cognitive psychology are being carried out. Neuro-psychological testing and / or standardization of scales, validity and reliability studies are carried out by conducting experimental researches for examining cognitive processes in healthy individuals. Computer-based versions of paper-pen type cognitive tasks and neuro-psychological tests can be used to perform field studies. Our laboratory is in the phase of installation.



Autobiographic Memory Research Laboratories (sleep laboratory)

Autobiographical Memory Research Laboratories are studying the memorization of past events and their relation to other factors such as emotion, language, age, excitement and personality. In this laboratory, Eyelink 2000Hz Eye Tracker, TOBII TX300 Tracking Device, High Capacity Computers and Monitors are used to measure eye movements and gaze direction precisely. Primarily, visual attention and reading processes are used in their work. Our laboratory is in the phase of installation.

Language, Communication and Mental Development Studies Laboratory

This laboratory has an observation room, an eye tracking system and test rooms where various experiments can be carried out. Work is being conducted with children and adults on issues related to environmental factors (bilingualism, gestures, interaction with peers), such as the relationship between language and attention, spatial perception, working memory, gestures, and cognitive development areas. The chambers have both the camera hardware and the means by which physiological measurements can be taken to provide both observational data collection. It is also possible to carry out experiments in which virtual environments can be created and investigated through virtual reality equipment. Our laboratory is in the phase of installation.



SPSS DATA ANALYSIS LABORATORY

The laboratories affiliated to the Information Technologies Center of our university offer their services to our students for the purpose of doing lectures, assignments and academic research. Laboratories have a system that is managed from a single center.

Psychotechnical/ Psychometrical Laboratory

Psychologists gain their professional experience by using devices such as the Vienna test in these laboratories with all the equipment used in the psychotherapeutic centers. Our laboratory is in the phase of installation.



Observation- Conversation and Experimental Laboratory

The meeting room allows for conducting social psychological studies in which group dynamics can be explored and subjects are experimented in groups in addition to conducting meetings and lectures for educational purposes.

In this part of the experimental psychology laboratory there is a functional near-infrared imaging system based on the measurement of the amount of oxygen in the hemoglobin molecule responsible for oxygen transport in tissues used to record neuro-physiological activity in the fore brain. Methodological richness (experimental and other methods that complement each other) is targeted in our research. Our laboratory is in the phase of installation.

ADVERTISEMENT ANALYSIS LABORATORY WITH EYE TRACKING APPLICATION

Regarding marketing studies that are increasing in recent years, thoughts and attitudes of consumers in relation with the packages of products, advertisements and shelve designs may be detected by making various physiological measurements with the assistance of various technological devices. Eye tracking method, which is one of the most critical technological devices that is used in this field, has been used for the last century in several fields of science, and it is being used intensely in the field of marketing in recent years. In this method, eye pupilmetric, eye tracking recorder and t-scopes are used. In this way, it is aimed to acquire quality in terms of product development, advertising and marketing by benefiting from the data, which explains the area on which the participants focus the most in advertisements. Thus, an area shall be opened for making multidisciplinary researches and analyses.

Department of Cinema and Television

It is important to create areas for students to practice in the formal education and training processes. It is aimed to create opportunities to apply in classroom or individually the devices they will encounter in media sector, studio, directing, green box-blue box shooting options, editing types, sound and light techniques and field works. In this way, it is planned to provide opportunity for students to gain practical experience in their working life. In our university, all the units with radio, television, cinema, new media, journalism and photography in their curriculum are able to practice in the studio. In addition, all of the promotional activities required for our university include the use of technical equipment, support of the technicians, making of the shootings by the students and the related experts, and post-production stages such as editing, voice recording are implemented.

Artificial Intelligence Laboratory

All modeling and analysis studies based on artificial intelligence and all artificial intelligence based development activities. Our laboratory is in the phase of installation.



Decision Dynamics Laboratory

Computerized modeling of Decision Making and Persuasion Processes and testing game design of various decision and persuasion processes. Our laboratory is in the phase of installation.



Social Dynamics Laboratory

Particularly the dissemination in the Social and Quantitative Media and the modeling of the propagation networks and persuasion processes resulting from these propagation. Our laboratory is in the phase of installation.



Trend Research Laboratories

Measuring the structural and functional characteristics of trends by modeling and analyzing social and human trends. Our laboratory is in the phase of installation.



New Media Laboratory

Different aspects of the new media are solved by modeling with the help of information technology. Our laboratory is in the phase of installation.



Leadership and Achievement Laboratory

Researching the activities on Leadership and Social Achievement with support of information technology. Our laboratory is in the phase of installation.

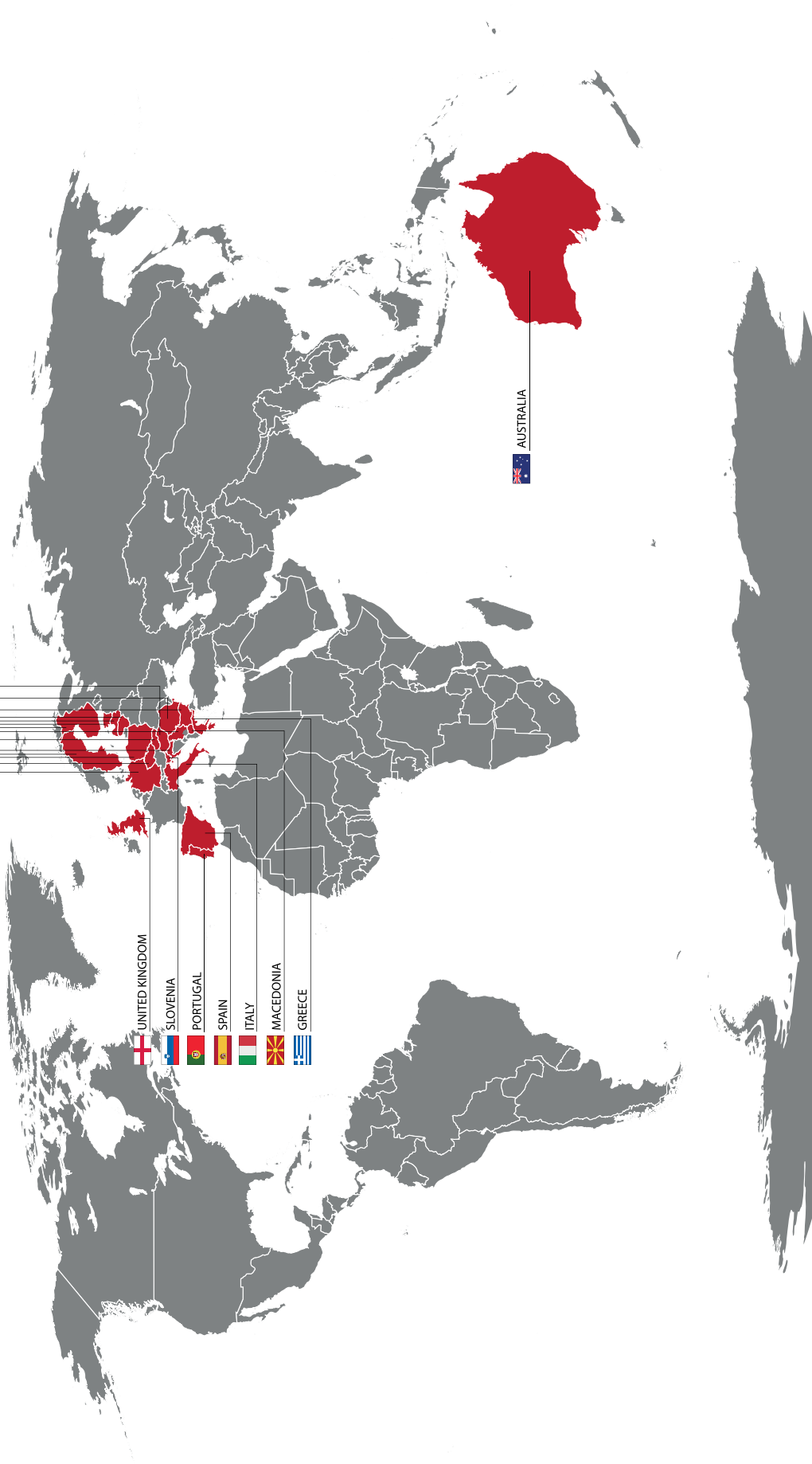

• IGU SALS

The SALS (Social and Academic Life Skills) course, which many students from Istanbul Gelisim University have attended, is being implemented in order to make students aware of the achievements of the university and the achievements for life success. The problems that students will have to deal with in order to adapt to the difference in post-secondary post-graduate performance and the things to be done for academic success are minimized by this course. In the SALS course, students learn about self-knowledge, communication techniques and communication management, goal setting, time management, effective coping with stress, group and community speaking skills and effective presentation skills. The purpose of this course application is to make the learned information combined with practice to make it permanent and permanent.

• ACADEMIC CONSULTANCY

Mentoring system is a guide that is made during the course of this trip to the students who are new to the university during the constantly developing and changing education process. Throughout this process, a successful mentor is needed in order to be successful, to keep the self-confidence and motivation high, and to be a leader in the business world. Mentoring system is a system based on mutual trust, patience and communication. Students who are new to the university in the mentoring program are included in groups of 8 or 10 students who lead students from major classes. Students who are new to the university will apply firstly for the problems they have experienced in adapting to academic life and changing social environment to their mentors. Mentors contribute to the integration of new students into college, the steps required for career development, and the formation of a common İGU culture.

• MENTORING PROGRAM

Mentorluk sistemi sürekli gelişen ve değişen eğitim süreci içerisinde üniversiteye yeni başlayan öğrencilere bu yolculuk süresince yapılan rehberliktir. Bu süreç boyunca başarılı olmak, çağı yakalamak, özgüveni ve motivasyonu yüksek tutmak, iş dünyasında lider olmak için başarılı bir mentora ihtiyaç duyulmaktadır. Mentorluk sistemi karşılıklı güven, sabır ve iletişime dayalı bir sistemdir. Mentorluk programında üniversiteye yeni başlayan öğrenciler, büyük sınıflardan öğrenci liderliğini yaptığı 8 ya da 10 kişilik gruplara dahil edilir. Üniversiteye yeni başlayan öğrenciler hem akademik hayata hem de değişen sosyal çevreye uyum konusunda yaşadıkları problemlerde ilk başvuracakları kişi mentor olan öğrenci rehberlerdir. Mentorlar üniversiteye yeni başlayan öğrencilerin birbirleri ile kaynaşması, kariyer gelişimleri için atmaları gereken adımlar konusunda ve ortak İGU kültürünün oluşması için katkıda bulunurlar.

• COUNSELING SERVICES (IGURAM)

IGURAM is a professional counseling service for individuals who know themselves, understand their behaviors, discover and develop their hidden powers, and face difficulties in dealing with events from time to time.

Process is based on speech based on principles such as confidentiality, trust, volunteerism, equal relationship, acceptance. The counselee becomes more aware of himself, produces solutions for himself, makes decisions and applies them with the help of a counselor. Individuals, even if they find themselves inadequate to solve their problems, find their problems with individual counseling services and they find the courage to confront them. IGURAM is a center where university students have a lot of specialized clinical psychology to talk about and share with their individual or social problems. As individuals are forced to adapt to changing and evolving world conditions, new peer groups may experience problems in the educational process as well. In order to support these problems and keep the standards of life better, we are carrying out small touches on the future with our expert team members as a developmental family. In the unit where the activities are carried out to support the individual, emotional and social development of the students, counseling services are provided by the appointment system during the school period and they are held in the form of sessions at designated times.
