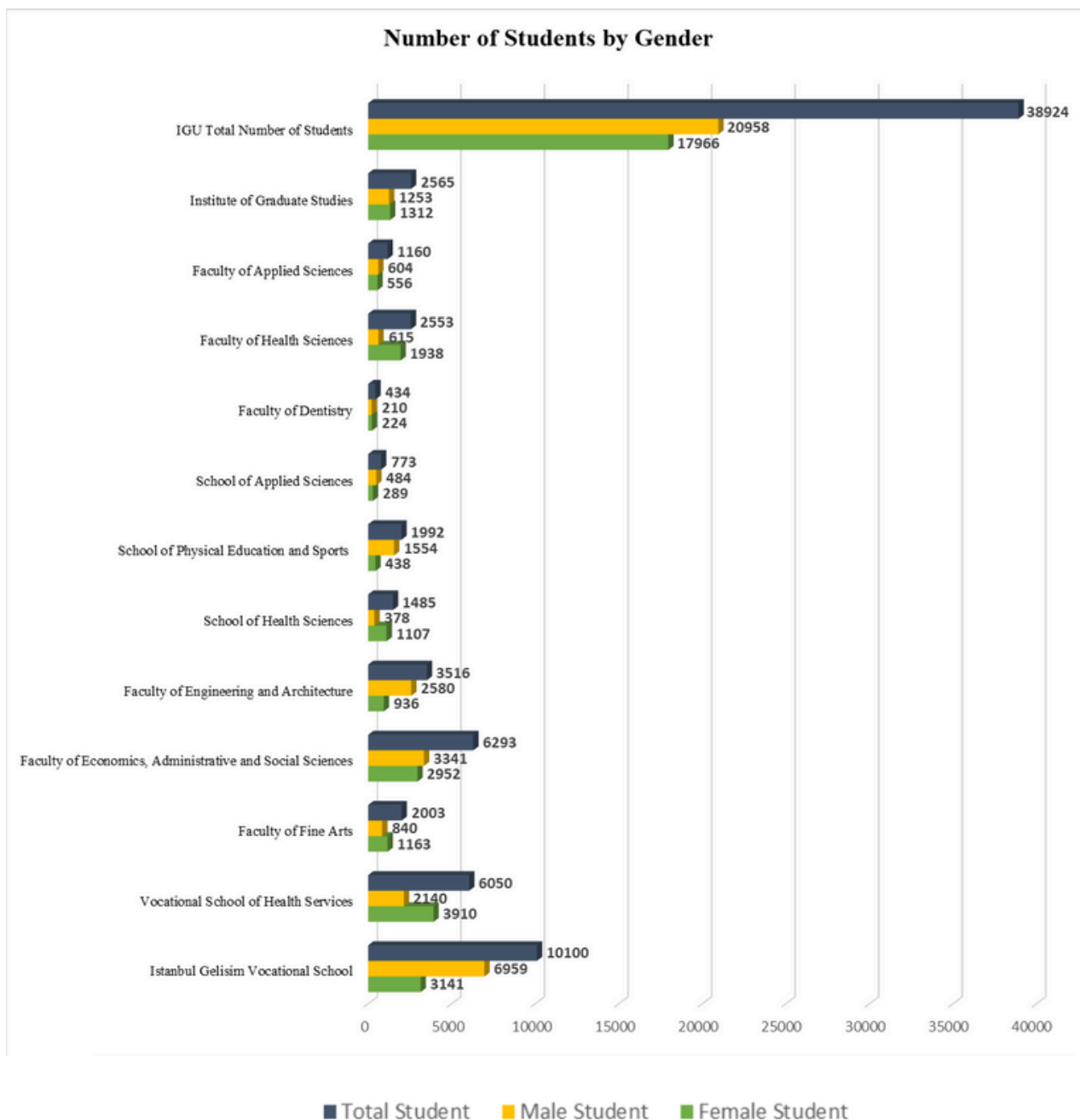


Figure 1. Number of Students by Gender

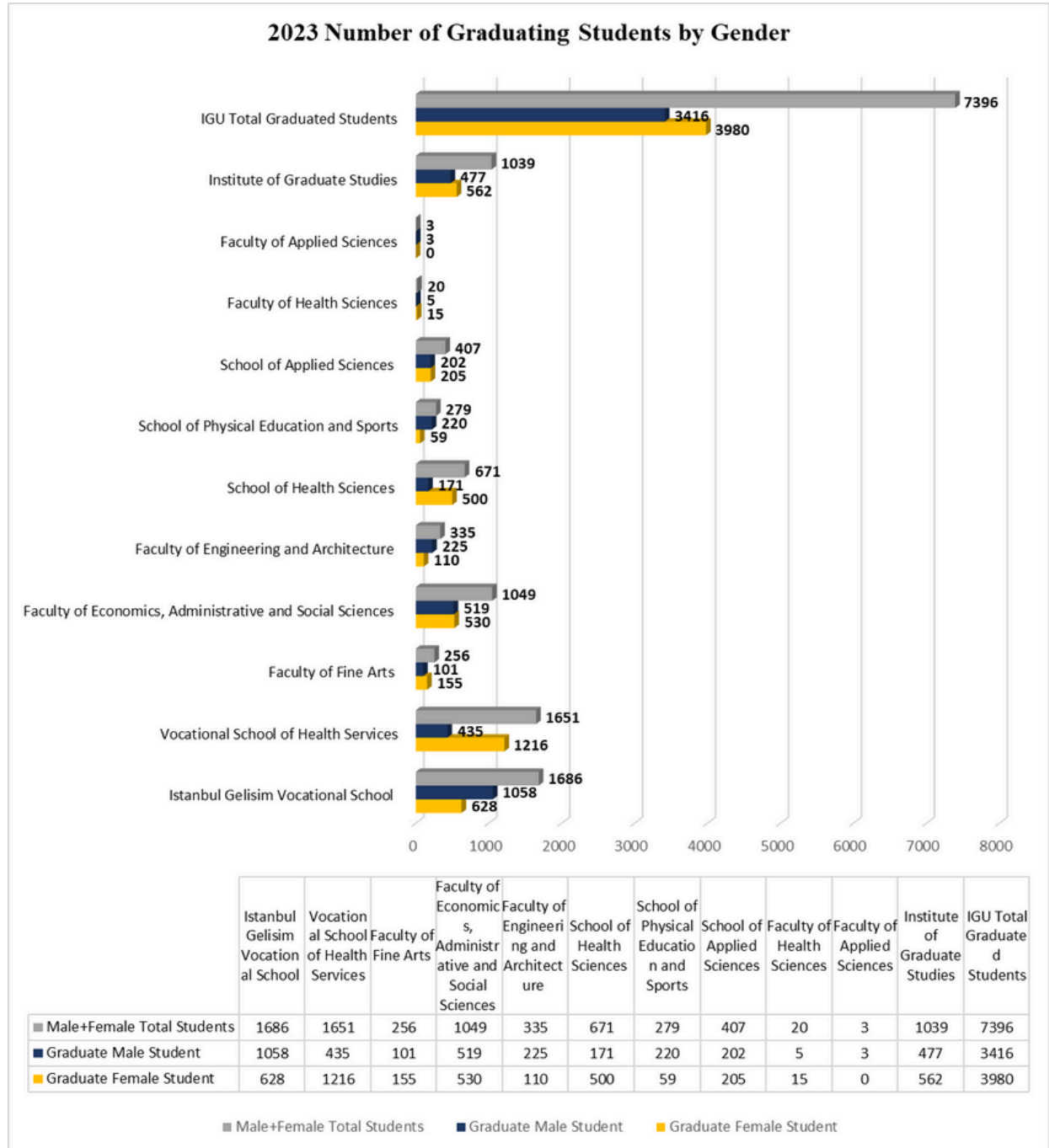


Figure 2. Number of Graduated Students by Gender in 2023

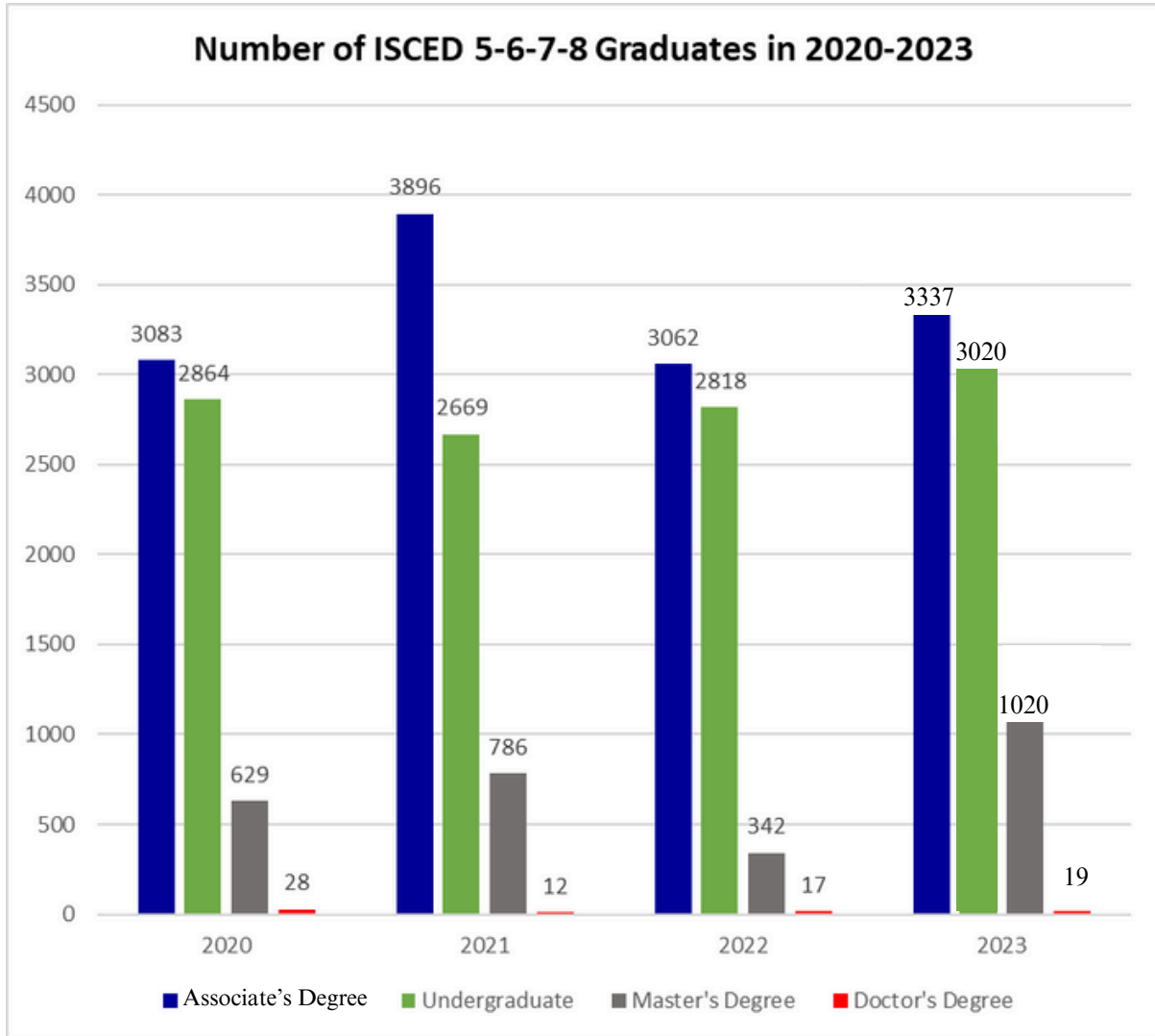


Figure 3. Number of ISCED 5-6-7-8 Graduates in 2019-2022 at IGU





2.1. Graduates with Teaching Qualifications

In 2023, the number of graduates with teaching qualifications at IGU is **2529** in total.

At the same time, IGU started to provide pedagogical formation education to both its own students and students studying at different universities in 2023, provided that they meet the application requirements. Pedagogical formation education is a certificate programme that is given to graduates of undergraduate programmes that are the source of the teaching profession or to final year students, which includes the achievements related to pedagogy. IGU started to provide pedagogical formation education to 92 departments in 2023.

3.1.Publicly Available Resources

IGU, adopting the principle of inclusiveness, has made all scientific publications produced by its members available to the public. Through Open Access, all academic resources produced directly and indirectly by IGU in 2023, including books, articles, theses, dissertations, papers, reports, and research data, are stored in a digital environment that meets international standards. It is instrumental in monitoring the University's academic performance, preserving resources for the long term, and making them available in accordance with copyright regulations to increase the impact of publications.

IGUSEM focuses on lifelong education and the needs in professional life. 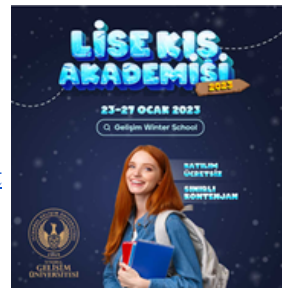

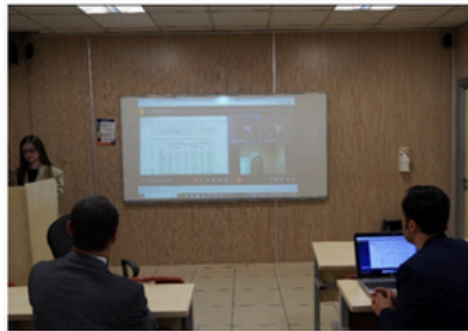
Activity Details: The nutrition-themed training activity was conducted online, reaching everyone who needed support on the topic.

Activity Details: Students and participants who wanted to participate in the tournaments of the Turkish championship organized by TÜSF in Istanbul participated in the tournaments.

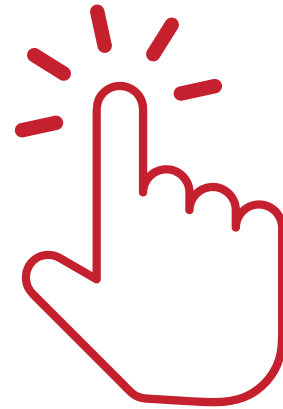

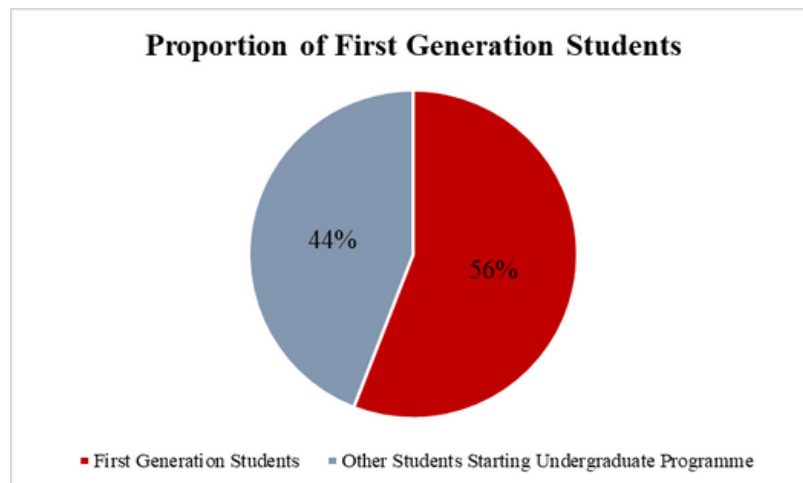


Figure 4. Proportion of First Generation Students

6.Sustainability-Oriented Courses
