

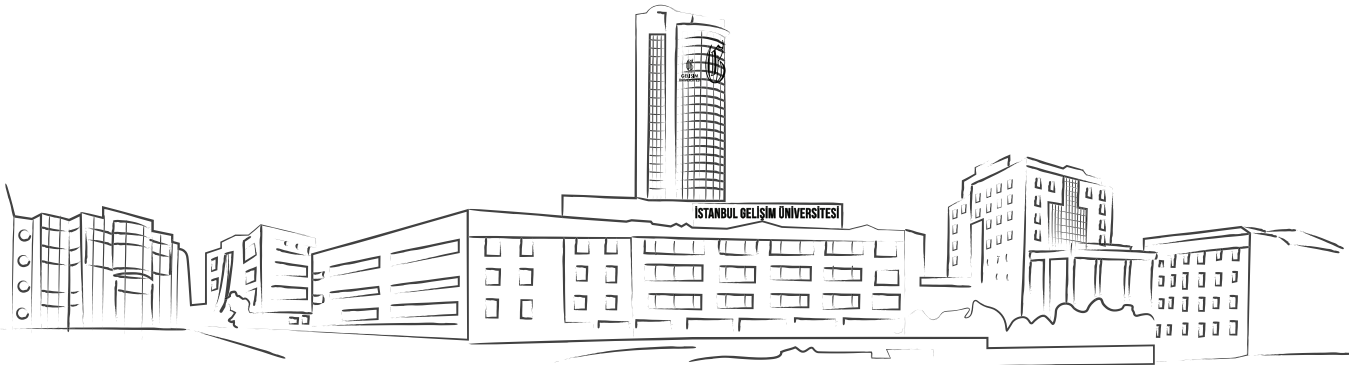

The age of 65 and above approves the restriction

In the study conducted with 120 elderly people with an average age of 68, the elderly were asked what they think of the restriction ban applied. In the research, it has been revealed that 60 percent of the elderly approve application of the isolation process to vulnerable groups and the elderly.

Prof. Dr. İsmail Tufan, founder of Tazelenme University which is the Turkey's first and only university of the elderly and provide education without profit making purpose and Gerontology Science, conducted a research with Lect. Gerontologist F. Sila Ayan from Istanbul Gelisim University School of Health Sciences. According to the research conducted with the participation of 120 students of Tazelenme University with an average age of 68, 56 percent of the

elderly consider the curfew applied to them as a right decision. According to the research, only 27 percent believe that there will be a decrease at elderly deaths, while 52 percent of the elderly agree that the curfew decision set for them is fair.

The video channel called “Gerçek Hikâyeler (True Stories)” on Youtube, which is an internet video platform, has recently drawn massive reaction due to its inappropriate content.

The titles of the videos in the channel give the shivers. The titles of some of the videos prepared to attract the attention of children are as follows: “My father makes me beg for money in the street to get money.” “My parents left me to die in the hospital.” “I stole my sister’s baby because she was a horrible mother.” “I bought myself a girlfriend.” “I adopt my father’s illegitimate child.” “My boyfriend can’t take his eyes off my mom.” The rating numbers of each of

the videos prepared as animated cartoons vary between one hundred thousand and one million. The channel, contains many videos that are prepared as animations to attract the attention of children, has 516 thousand subscribers. It is estimated that children constitute a large part of the audience due to the fact that all the contents were prepared as animated films.

THINGS TO KNOW



ABOUT NEW CORONAVIRUS



All necessary measures are taken for the **coronavirus** revealed in Turkey and the World at **Istanbul Gelisim University**. **Things to know about coronavirus are as follows:**

What are the new coronavirus symptoms?

- The most common symptoms are **fever, cough and respiratory distress**.
- In severe cases, **pneumonia, severe respiratory failure, kidney failure and death** may occur
- Incubation period is between **2 and 14 days**.

How is the virus transmitted?

- It can be transmitted by the contact of the droplets caused by **coughing and sneezing** with the contact of the **mouth, nose and eyes** of other individuals in certain environment and by touching the surfaces where the droplets adhere and taking hands **into the mouth, nose or eyes**.

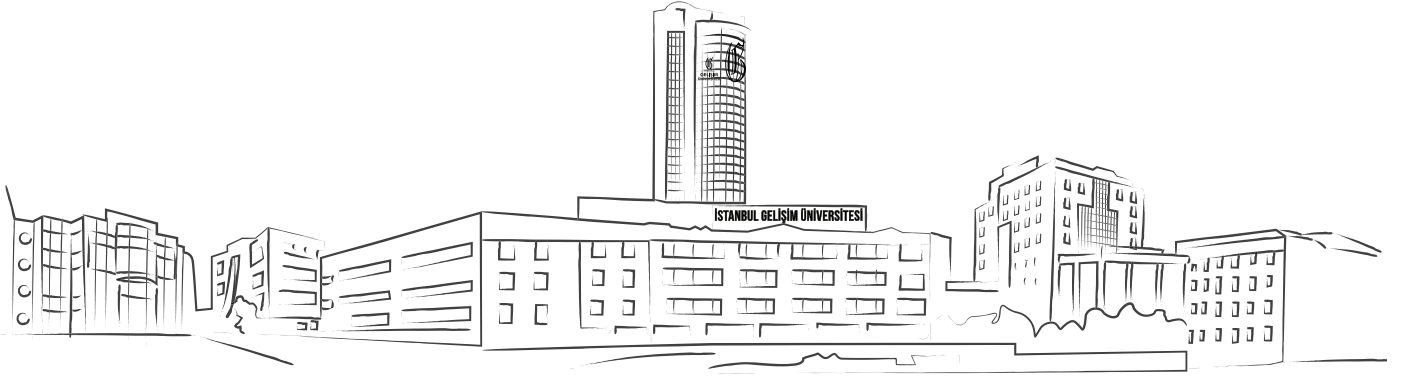
What to do to be protected from the virus?

- When **coughing or sneezing**, the mouth and nose should be covered with a **disposable tissue**, if there is no handkerchief, the mouth should be closed with the **upper sleeve or elbow**, not with the palms.
- **Handshaking and hugging** should be avoided.
- **Mouth, nose and eyes** should not be touched with dirty hands.
- Hands must be washed for **at least 20 seconds** in accordance with the **Handwashing Instructions** found in the toilets. In the absence of water and soap, **alcohol-containing hand antiseptics** should be used. **Cologne of 70-80 degrees** also serve as disinfectants.
- Offices and classrooms must be **ventilated hourly**.
- Places frequently used by many people such as common areas and door handles should be **disinfected every 2 hours**.
- Hands **must be washed** after using **public transportation**.
- Because the virus progresses faster in people with low immune system; **a balanced and healthy diet** is required. Foods **must be washed thoroughly** before consumption.

What to do if there are symptoms?

- If you have come from countries with infections **in the past 14 days**, apply to the **nearest healthcare facility** by wearing **a surgical mask**.
- If you are **coughing, have a fever and have difficulty at breathing**, apply to the **nearest healthcare facility** by wearing **a surgical mask**.
- **Always wear your mask** when you are in the same room with **a person who is recommended insulation** at home.
