Introduction

Istanbul Gelisim University considers non-governmental organizations an important stakeholder in the achievement of sustainable development vision. In 2019, in addition to the afore-mentioned cooperation, 27 private companies carried out studies to develop their capacities in the field of sustainable business by receiving research, consultancy and education services from Istanbul Gelisim University within the scope of increasing the capacity of the private sector by producing new information in partnership in education, support, industry and technology.

2.2. Partnerships for Technology Development and R&D Support

As the importance attached to technology, R&D and innovation have increased in accordance with National Science, Technology and Innovation Strategy, increasing technology and innovation activities in a private sector-oriented manner, commercialisation of research results and increasing the competitiveness of our country with branded technology-intensive products are among our main goals specified by our country.

In this regard, the main goal of Istanbul Gelisim University is to increase the support given to technology, R&D and innovation studies and to support the cooperation and joint study culture in this field in accordance with the 11th Development Plan.

In accordance with this goal, the researchers and academics of Istanbul Gelisim University develop national and international projects while our research and application centres, aiming to produce knowledge and value as well as to conduct quality research and publication to transform these productions into economic added value, contribute to this vision by establishing partnerships and cooperation with other research institutions at home and abroad. In order to fulfil all these activities, there are 21 Research and Application Centers at Istanbul Gelisim University.

You can find information about these projects and activities carried out by the afore-mentioned cooperation.

- In 2018 May, the production steps of the flying car project, showing that to what extent Turkey and Istanbul Gelisim University use technological developments well and they can compete with the countries with developed technology in the world, were taken. In this project, the mechanical laboratory at the university was actively used in the production process, which was integrated with companies under university-industry cooperation.

The main body of the Flying Car was completed at the end of June, and thus, the Flying Car project is no longer a dream but a real structure. The basic flight tests of the Flying Car project, of which electronic equipment, security tests and improvements lasted for 1.5 months depending on these tests, started in July. As of January 2019, the studies on completing the first flying car in Turkey were accelerated with body shell manufactured based on the design.

It is planned to use the car, having remote control and central driving feature and which can travel both on land and in air, in civil aviation and military, health and cargo transportation. The flying car investment was also drawn great interest in the Turkish press.

- In order to offer an alternative solution to the problem of searching for pharmacies on duty, the "Eczamatik" project was developed by Istanbul Gelisim University. It was determined in a study conducted by the university that people in Turkey and around the world have difficulties in accessing pharmacies on duty. In order to solve this problem, the Eczamatik (Drugmatic) project, where drugs can be taken at any time of the day, was initiated and a prototype was produced.



The practical electronic pharmacy, which was produced within the scope of the project and attracted great attention in the press, will serve 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. By entering the information on the doctor's prescription into the Eczamatik, citizens having difficulties in finding

pharmacies on duty will be able to take the medicines they need. This newly developed project aims to provide people with drugs in places where no pharmacy can be reached to and when finding pharmacies on duty is not possible; thus, citizens will be able to see the price of the drugs, how much they cost in total, and pay by cash or credit card.



Urgent and widely used drugs will be stored at the appropriate temperature and delivered to the buyer in the best way according to demand through this newly

The study carried out with the residents of Limontepe, one of the slums of Izmir, revealed that the number of women who have not yet experienced setting foot in the places that are the symbols of the city, despite being settled there for decades, is at a considerable level. In my research where I focus on women's experience and the factors that shape it, the digital content of the project, which aims to make a theoretical contribution to discussions on gender, mobility and urban rights, as well as to develop suggestions for overcoming existing obstacles to women's mobility, are shared in the links below;

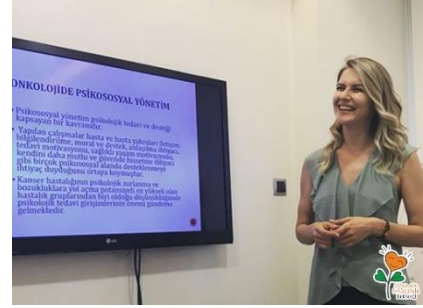
