Prof. Dr. Bahri Sahin, the Rector of IGU, stated that the main goal of Istanbul Gelisim University is to raise individuals who have adopted human, social and universal values, pioneered scientific and technological developments, internalized the values of the society, and had the equipment to represent their country in every international field. Prof. Dr. Bahri Sahin, the Rector of IGU, said, "We are achieving significant successes by moving forward with the vision of becoming a Research University. We have 40 thousand registered students. This is an indication that our university is one of the most preferred universities. We are highly ecstatic about this. We have around 6 thousand registered international students and students from 127 countries are studying at IGU. Stating that it is necessary to work together for quality education and quality generation, Abdulkadir Gayretli, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Istanbul Gelisim University, said, "We are happy to be among the top 4 foundation universities in Turkey in QS, one of the most respected higher education rating agencies in the world. "It is used effectively in one of the blood cancer derivatives"

The opening lecture of Istanbul Gelisim University 2023-2024 Academic Year Opening Ceremony was given by Prof. Dr. Fikrettin Sahin, Primary Member of TUBA (Turkish Academy of Sciences). Giving a lecture on "The Potential Use of Boron Compounds in Regenerative Medicine", Sahin said, "When we look at the reserves, 73% of boron minerals are in Turkey currently. We are the richest country in the world. If we explain where it is used in the health sector; there is a treatment method called Boron Neutron Capture Therapy. This is a type of radiation therapy used in cancer treatment. Another is Bortezomib, which is used effectively in one of the multiple myeloma, that is, blood cancer derivatives. Apart from this, when we look at its use in the field of health, we see that there is a boron element in the structure of some antibiotics. When we look at the results of scientific studies, we see that boron has positive effects on wound healing, increasing antioxidant enzyme activities in the blood, preventing heavy metal poisoning and activating the immune system. Looking at it now, the globe has generated a large number of commercially available supplement goods. These are especially; products used in arthritis, bone growth problems, some cancer diseases, healing of brain functions, hormone regulator and wound healing."

The story of the Independence March is the story of the War of Independence

After the War of Independence started and the Grand National Assembly was established in Ankara, there was a will to compose a "National Anthem" that would support the national awakening, raise the morale of the people and the soldiers, create excitement and strengthen the national identity. In order to meet the army's demand in this direction, the Ministry of Education was appointed to open first a lyrics and then a composition competition. The Ministry of Education published a nationwide circular on September 18, 1920, inviting poets to write the lyrics of the National Anthem.

724 poems came to the competition from all corners of the country. But, except for a few, most of them were neither literary nor satisfactory in terms of the enthusiasm they created. Thereupon, with the efforts of the Minister of Education, Hamdullah Suphi Bey, Mehmet Akif Bey, who recently came to Ankara and worked in various cities of Anatolia to invite the people to the War of Independence, was assigned to write the poem.

The poem written by Mehmet Akif was accepted as the National Anthem of Turkey with great enthusiasm in the Parliament on March 12, 1921. Immediately afterwards, a second competition was opened to select a composition suitable for this lyric. Although the exact number is not known, it is thought that around a hundred compositions participated in this competition. However, since there were no musicians in Ankara at that time who could evaluate these works, it was not possible to conclude the composition competition due to the intervening wars.

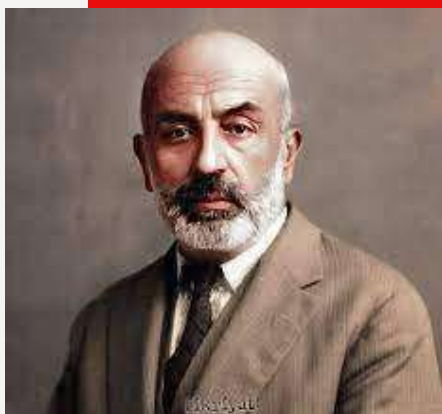

The evaluation could only be made through a commission established in Istanbul at the beginning of 1923, after the Great Victory. Among the works received, the commission found Ali Rifat (Çağatay) Bey's composition suitable to be the National Anthem. However, this evaluation was criticized because the composition was too slow and in the form of Eastern music. As a matter of fact, this composition was not officially declared as the National Anthem of the Republic of Turkey until 1930, and anthems composed by different musicians were sung in different parts of the country. The main reasons why the composition did not become widespread were that it resembled a song rather than an anthem, that it was difficult to perform, and that it was not memorable.

This confusion ended in 1930, when the work of another composer, Osman Zeki Üngör, was accepted as the National Anthem. Osman Zeki Üngör says in an interview that the inspiration for this anthem was the hooves of the Turkish cavalry entering Izmir.

Transition Process to Turkish Literature in the Republican Era

Turkish literature, one of the oldest, most established and rich literatures in the world, has progressed in three branches until today. The first of these can be stated as Pre-Islamic Turkish Literature, the second as Turkish Literature Developing Under the Influence of Islam, and the last one as Turkish Literature Developing under the Influence of Western Literature. There are two periods in Turkish literature that developed under the influence of Western literature; It can be thought that the Republic period was the period that prepared Turkish literature for the transition to Turkish literature.

When it is necessary to talk about the transition process to Turkish literature in the Republican period, the previous periods of Turkish literature should also be mentioned. These processes are the literature of the National Literature Movement and the War of Independence Period.

In order to stop the rapidly continuing weakening of the Ottoman Empire, Turkism is one of the three styles of politics determined as a.) Islamism, b.) Ottomanism and c.) Turkism; It was adopted by names such as Ömer Seyfettin, Ziya Gökalp and Ali Canip YONTEM. The publication of the "Genç Kalemler" magazine, which these writers published together in Thessaloniki, and the article "New Language" signed by Ömer Seyfettin, brings the National literary movement to the fore in terms of the Turkish language. It can be stated that the publication of Genç Kalemler magazine in Thessaloniki was considered as a precaution to highlight Turkish nationalism there while the Balkan nations were defending their nationalism against the Ottoman Empire. On the other hand, the precautions stated in the "New Language" article that should be taken for the progress of Ottoman Turkish can be stated as the harbinger / pioneer of the language revolution that will take place after the proclamation of the republic.

In this part of the article, if we need to talk about the literature of the War of Independence period; This period is the process of the artists who lived at that time and described the War of Independence in their works. It is possible to specify the names of these artists and their works that describe our War of Independence and/or the changes experienced at that time in prose as follows:

Refik Halit KARAY: Homeland Stories, **Yakup Kadri KARAOSMANOĞLU:** Sodom and Gomorrah, Wild, National War Stories, On the Way to the Homeland, **Halide Edip ADIVAR:** Turk's Test with Fire, Shirt of Fire, **Mithat Cemal KUNTAY:** Three Istanbuls, **Memduh Şevket ESENDAL:** With Ayaşlı Tenants, **Reşat Nuri GÜNTEKİN:** Green Night. In poetry, **Mehmet Akif ERSOY**, the poet of our National Anthem, and Yahya Kemal BEYATLI, our poet who adopted the concept of "pure poetry", are names that should definitely be mentioned.

In addition to these names, when it comes to Young / Early Republican Period Turkish literature, poetry movements such as "Five Syllables" and "Seven Torches" should also be mentioned. If we pay attention to the names of the artists in the groups mentioned above; It is understood that they are intermediate generation artists who lived before the proclamation of the republic and in the last period of the Ottoman state and took their surnames after the surname law. It is possible to find traces of the social events experienced during the transition from the Ottoman Empire to the young Republic of Turkey in the works of this intermediate generation, which is a great richness for our culture. It can be estimated that these social events are social events seen in the life of the individual, family and society. For example, what happened in Anatolia during the War of Independence, what civil servants experienced in the towns to which they were appointed, or what a young teacher experienced in the town or village to which he was appointed.

The current process of Turkish literature can be described as modern and postmodern Turkish literature in the Republican period. In addition, it should be noted that there is also Turkish Folk Literature that has been continuous since its beginning. Of course, it is not easy to briefly explain here the history of the transition of a very rich literature like ours to the literature of the Republican period. As a matter of fact, resource books full of pages have been prepared for this purpose.

With this article, it is aimed to explain in general terms how the transition process to Turkish Literature in the Republican Era took place.

OCTOBER INTERVIEW

ACADEMICIAN: PROF. DR. SELAMİ AYDIN:

“When choosing a profession, they should act entirely in line with their own interests and abilities and develop themselves for this purpose”

Thank you for accepting our FoAS Monthly e-Bulletin interview request. First, let's get to know you a little bit. What is education and what is not?

I would also like to thank you for your interview request. I work as a faculty member at Istanbul Medeniyet University, Department of Foreign Languages Education. I conduct scientific studies on psychological and technological factors in language learning processes.

In my opinion, education has three dimensions. These dimensions; It can be considered as the individual's happy and peaceful exit from the educational process he/she experiences, the outcomes obtained as a result of the education making meaningful contributions to the peace of the society, and the education contributing to the development of the country. In this context, education; I can define it as a process in which the economic and social development of the country is ensured by sufficient, talented and caring people.

Mr. Aydın, how do you evaluate the legacy that the Republic inherited from the Ottoman Empire in the field of education? What are your general thoughts about the Turkish education system in the Republican period?

When evaluating education during the Ottoman period, it may be possible to say that education reached the ideal point in certain periods, while there were collapses in certain periods. However, in general terms, we can say that education started in madrasahs during the Ottoman period, and today's non-formal and formal education coincides with the last periods. Although we think that the main difference is the transition from religion-based education to a secular system, religious-based education has not been abandoned through Imam Hatip High Schools. However, it is possible to say that today the curriculum has become quite diversified in subjects such as science, social and vocational education. Another fundamental difference is in terms of dissemination of education. While access to education in the Ottoman Empire was generally possible for individuals living in central locations, today in our country education is provided not only in cities but also in the most remote villages through compulsory education. Throughout these processes, we do not experience any problems in terms of important points such as gender equality and access to education.

OCTOBER INTERVIEW

What are the basic principles on which the education system of the Republic of Turkey is based?

The basic goals of education in our country are pursued in accordance with the official ideology at the founding stage of our state. The situation regarding the duration of compulsory education in our country is also one of the basic principles. As I just mentioned, ensuring gender equality and having access to education through infrastructure is also an important point. Issues such as the recent expansion of education at university level, the innovations we have encountered in teacher education, the expansion of foreign language teaching, and the inclusion of basic knowledge and skills in course programs and contents can also be emphasized in terms of these principles.

What are the gains of the modern education system for Türkiye? How have translation activities affected this modern education system?

Undoubtedly, each system has its own advantages and disadvantages. In other words, an education system in itself is neither completely ideal nor completely bad. For example, unfortunately, it is not possible to say that the experience-based, problem-solving and student-centered education that Atatürk tried to establish through John Dewey during his time is applicable today. Some important issues such as failure to make correct employment plans, central exams, and rote-based teaching have not yet been resolved. In this sense, I do not think that it would be beneficial to establish an education and training system through translation. Instead, I think it would be important and useful to develop policies based on the results of scientific studies.

What are the main problems encountered in the education system during the Republic period? What are your thoughts on the state of today's education system?

Considering the conditions after the First World War and the War of Independence, I must say that we are going through difficult times not only in the field of education but also in terms of social and economic conditions. I think that the important studies carried out on education in the following period were limited to Atatürk's lifetime. Of course, while not ignoring the ideal dimensions of our education system, I have to say that we have a long way to go when we compare it with the systems of countries that defeated the Second World War, such as Germany and Japan. I think that as long as the individual's interests and abilities are considered as a way through central exams, as long as teacher education is not reached to an ideal point and employment plans are not made, the current problems will continue exponentially.

OCTOBER INTERVIEW

What are your suggestions for university students to increase their awareness and become conscious individuals?

I recommend that our students acquire knowledge and skills not to pass exams but to improve themselves. Ok when choosing a career I think they should act in line with their own interests and abilities and develop themselves for this purpose.

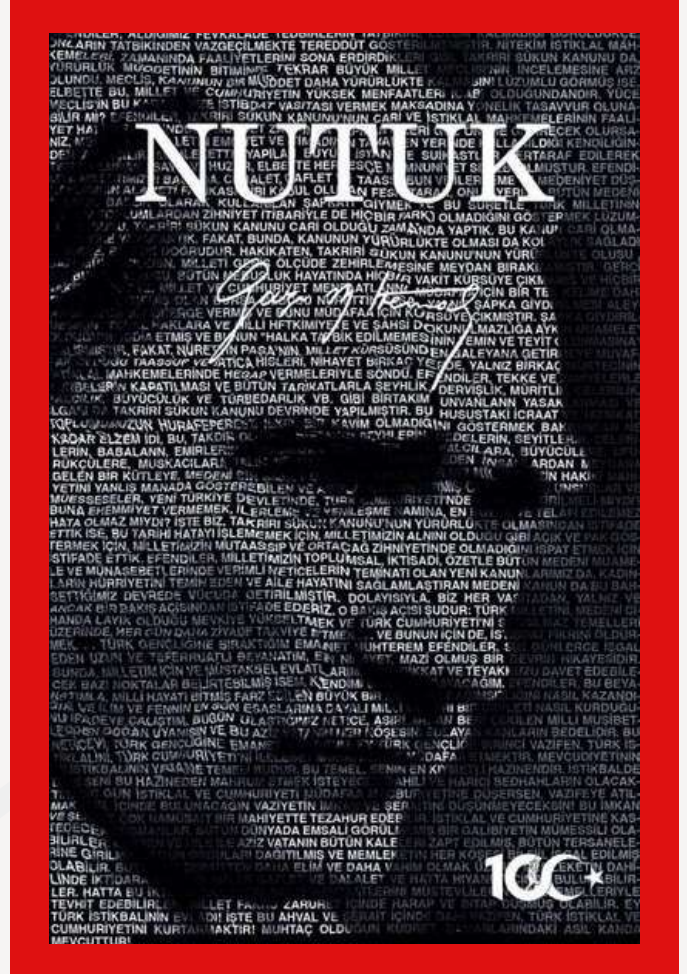

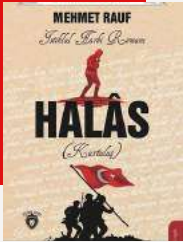

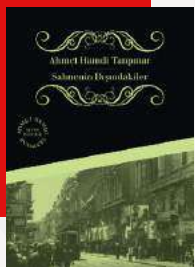
The Shirt of Flame / Halide Edib Adıvar
