

It attracted attention with the results it received in the categories of Economy, Environmental Science, Business Administration, Energy, Social Sciences and Engineering.

The results of "SCImago University Rankings 2024", which measures the social, scientific impact and innovation of universities around the world, have been announced. Aiming to give a general idea about universities by measuring their performance in terms of research, innovation and social impact, SCImago University Ranking helps students obtain information about a university's education quality, effectiveness and prestige.



Proceeding with the vision of "World University", IGU attracted attention with the work it carried out for its students and the opportunities it provided. It once again proved its success with the degrees it received in different fields in the SCImago University Rankings 2024 results.

Istanbul Gelisim University draws attention with its research studies in different fields in the 2024 results of SCImago, one of the university evaluation organizations. World universities ranking organization Times Higher Education (THE) Impact Ranking was announced in 2023. In the ranking, Istanbul Gelisim University, among 1591 universities from 112 countries, achieved success by ranking 12th among Turkish universities in the "Accessible Clean Energy" category for the first time this year.

In the list of 1591 universities in the Times Higher Education (THE) 2023 ranking, the world's leading higher education rating agency based in the UK, the success of Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) was graded in six different categories in line with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. Apart from our two programs authorized by DGCA, the licensing processes for the Approved Cabin Crew Basic Training Organization Certificate for Civil Aviation Cabin Services Turkish and English Programs and the Approved Ground Handling Training Organization Certificate for Civil Air Transport Management Turkish and English Programs are continuing at the DGCA.

Food Allergy and Allergenic Foods

Lect. Aslı MUSLU CAN Food Technology Program

In 1906, the term allergy was first used as "hypersensitivity" by Australian pediatrician Clemens von Pirquet and was defined as an exaggerated or unexpected immune response of the body to an allergen or antigen.

Mechanism of food allergy; the first study on the development of allergic diseases was in 1921. Researchers named Prausnitz and Küstner conducted experiments on themselves. In the experiment, Küstner, who was allergic to fish, injected his mixture into the skin of Prausnitz, who was allergic to grass but not to fish, and after a certain period of time, he followed the reddening and blistering reactions that suddenly appeared when fish extract was injected into the sensitized skin area. Of course, let me put it another way: A food allergy is a specific and reproducible hypersensitivity reaction of the body to a food. This reaction is usually to proteins in the food. Allergic reactions usually range from mild to severe. While mild reactions usually present with symptoms such as itching, rash or mild swelling of the skin, severe reactions can lead to a condition known as anaphylaxis, which can be life-threatening. Therefore, food allergies should be taken seriously and evaluated appropriately.

In studies, researchers have stated that food allergy is an important public health problem and that it is very difficult to determine the incidence of food allergies because of various factors. It has been reported in studies that food allergy is high in children and that this may extend into adulthood.

The Food Codex Food Labeling and Consumer Information Regulation No. 29960, published in Resmi Gazete on January 26, 2017, entered into force on January 1, 2020. With this regulation numbered 29960, it has become mandatory to inform consumers of allergen information on foods consumed in places of mass consumption, such as canteens, restaurants, schools and hospitals. In the content of this regulation, information on any allergenic ingredient used in the production or preparation of food, or any allergenic processing aid or ingredients obtained with an allergenic substance must be included in the menus according to certain rules. In Regulation 29960, the definition of places of mass consumption is defined as places where food is made ready for consumption and offered to the end consumer. These places include all restaurants, canteens, schools and hospitals that offer ready-to-eat catering services, including mobile vehicles, fixed or mobile counters.

Allergic diseases are an important problem in our country. The incidence of allergies in children is high and the incidence of allergies varies according to regions. In a study, egg allergy is common in the Mediterranean, Black Sea, Central Anatolia and Eastern Anatolia regions, while milk allergy is more common in the Aegean and Marmara regions. The reason for the geographical characteristics of food allergy is the changes in eating habits and cooking.

According to the Food Allergen and Labeling and Consumer Protection Act passed in the US in 2004, allergen notification has been made mandatory for all foods, both domestic and imported. They recognized eight food groups as allergens and made it mandatory to indicate them on labels. These are milk, eggs, fish (e.g. bass, halibut, cod), shellfish (e.g. crab, lobster, shrimp), nuts (e.g. almonds, walnuts), peanuts, wheat and soybeans. (2)

In the Turkish Food Codex Regulation on Food Labeling and Informing Consumers, 14 allergens causing allergy and intolerance have been reported.

- 1. Gluten-containing cereals; wheat, rye, barley and oats
- 2. crustaceans and their products
- 3. eggs and egg products
- 4. fish and fish products
- 5. peanuts and peanut products
- 6. soybeans and soybean products
- 7. milk and dairy products (including lactose)
- 8. Hard-shelled fruits: Almonds (Amygdalus communis L.), hazelnuts (Corylus avellana), walnuts (Juglans regia), cashews (Anacardium occidentale), pecans (Carya illinoiesis (Wangenh.) K.Koch), brazil nuts (Bertholletia excelsa), pistachios (Pistacia vera), macadamia nuts and Queensland nuts (Macadamia ternifolia) and their products

- 9. Celery and celery products
- 10. Mustard and mustard products
- 11. Sesame seeds and sesame seed products
- 12. Sulfur dioxide and sulfides (for products ready for consumption or prepared according to manufacturers' instructions, with a concentration calculated in terms of total SO2 greater than 10 mg/kg or 10 mg/L)
- 13. Lupins and lupin products
- 14. Molluscs and their products

According to the regulation, allergenic food warning must be made on all products using the above-mentioned foods. (3)

As a result of the efforts to increase the quality of legal professions and to ensure that graduates have a profession as a result of the measurement and evaluation to be made among the graduates, the Entrance Examination for Law Professions and Administrative Jurisdiction Preliminary Examination, which is regulated in Article 41 of the Higher Education Law No. 2547, entered into force on 24.10.2019.

Regulation on Entrance Examination for Law Professions and Preliminary Examination for Administrative Judiciary

Following the legal regulation, the Ministry of Justice published the <u>"Regulation on Entrance Examination for Law Professions and Administrative Judiciary Preliminary Examination"</u> in the Official Gazette dated 08.05.2024 and numbered 32540.

In the Regulation;

- The Entrance Examination for Law Professions will be applied to those who enrolled in higher education institutions after 24/10/2019 and graduated after 31/3/2024,
- Those who have graduated from the Faculty of Law and those who have graduated from a foreign faculty of law and have obtained a certificate of equivalence by taking the exam and succeeding in the courses that are incomplete according to the programs of the faculties of law in Turkey can participate in the exam,
- The Law Professions Entrance Examination will be held twice a year, in April and September, by ÖSYM in accordance with the protocol and other conditions are specified.

With the concept of legal professions expressed in the Regulation, the professions of judge, prosecutor, lawyer and notary public are listed as legal professions.

It is regulated that the exams will be held by ÖSYM and in the second part of the regulation, the exam announcements will be made on the website of the Ministry of Justice at least 15 days before the exam applications, as well as the Entrance Examination for Legal Professions will be held twice a year in April and September.

Those who have graduated from the aforementioned departments as of the exam date will be able to apply for these exams. The exams to be held by ÖSYM will consist of at least 100 multiple-choice questions in the form of a test. Those who score at least 70 points out of 100 full points will be considered successful.

The subjects to be asked in the exams and the distribution of points are also included in the regulation.

Minister of Justice Yılmaz TUNÇ made the following statements regarding the purpose of the exam system and what is expected in terms of its results: "The regulation, which we have completed the work on the Entrance Examination for Legal Professions and Administrative Judicial Preliminary Examination, which we have implemented in order to provide better quality legal services to our citizens, was published in the Official Gazette. The quality of judicial services will further increase with the Entrance Examination for Legal Professions and Administrative Judicial Preliminary Examination. It will be necessary to pass the Entrance Examination for Legal Professions in order to start lawyer internship and to take the Assistant Judge and Assistant Prosecutor Examination. The exam will be applied for those who enrolled in higher education institutions after 24/10/2019 and graduated after 31/3/2024. I wish convenience to all candidates who will take the Entrance Examination for Legal Professions and the Administrative Judiciary Preliminary Examination."
