It has been a controversial issue about what Godot is. Most people share view that Godot stands for God. On the contrary, Beckett lets them down by saying: "had I meant God I would have said God and not Godot" (McDonald, 2006).



It is possible to say that having witnessed the World War II, people lose their faith in religion and try to find something to hold on. In his play, Beckett keeps his characters busy with waiting so that they can live on just like human beings. In other words, he asks an existential question:

"Why do humans exist?

French theatre critic Sylvain Zegel points out that: "These two men are feeble and energetic, cowardly

and courageous; they bicker, amuse themselves, are bored, speak to each other without understanding. They do all this to keep busy. To pass time. To live or to give themselves the illusion that they are living. They are certain of only one thing: they are waiting for Godot. Who is Godot?

They don't know" (1953).

70 years of waiting: It has been 70 years since it was performed for the first time.




